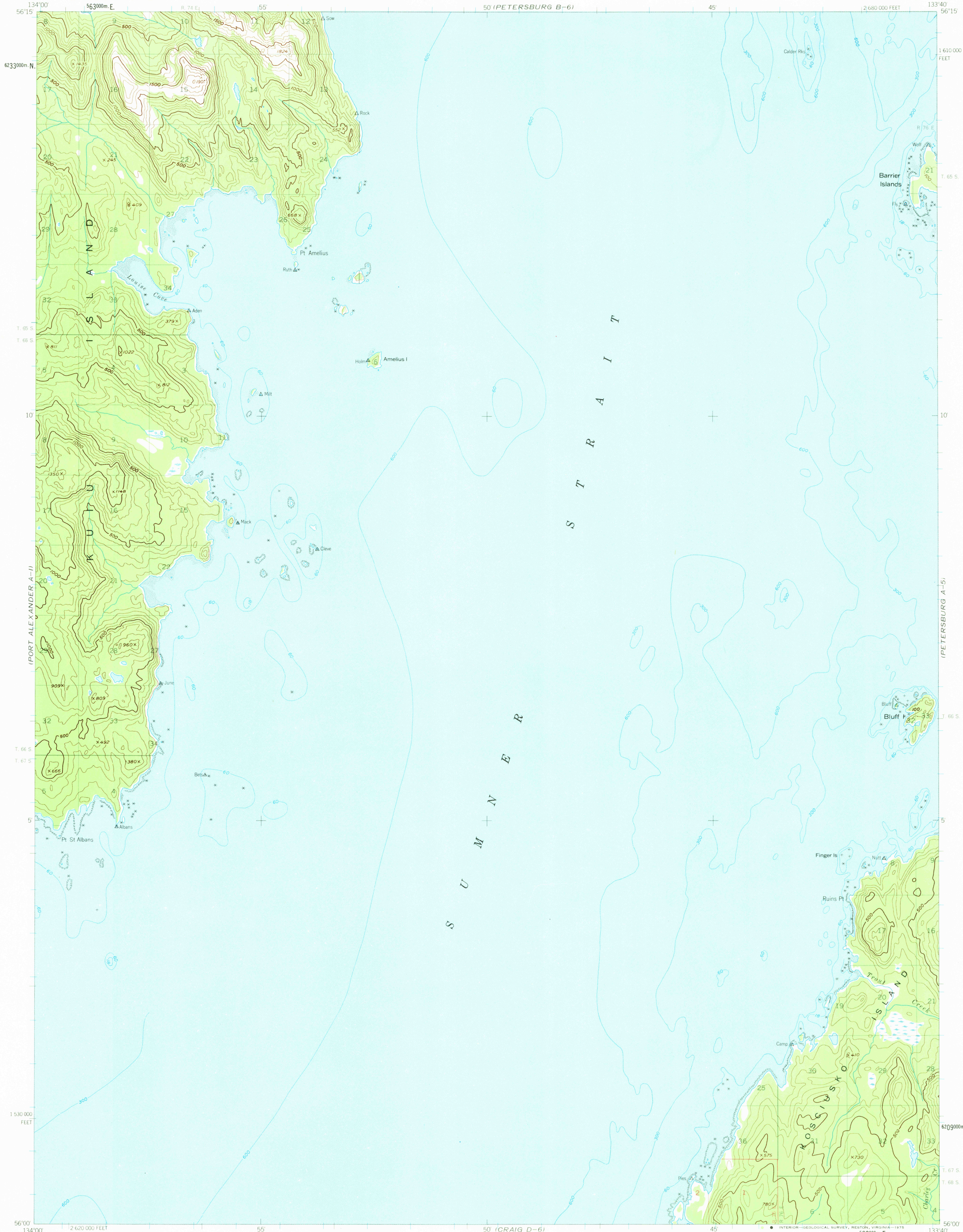

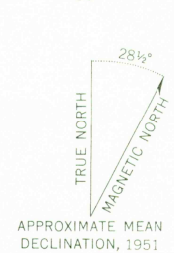
PETERSBURG (A-6) QUADRANGLE
