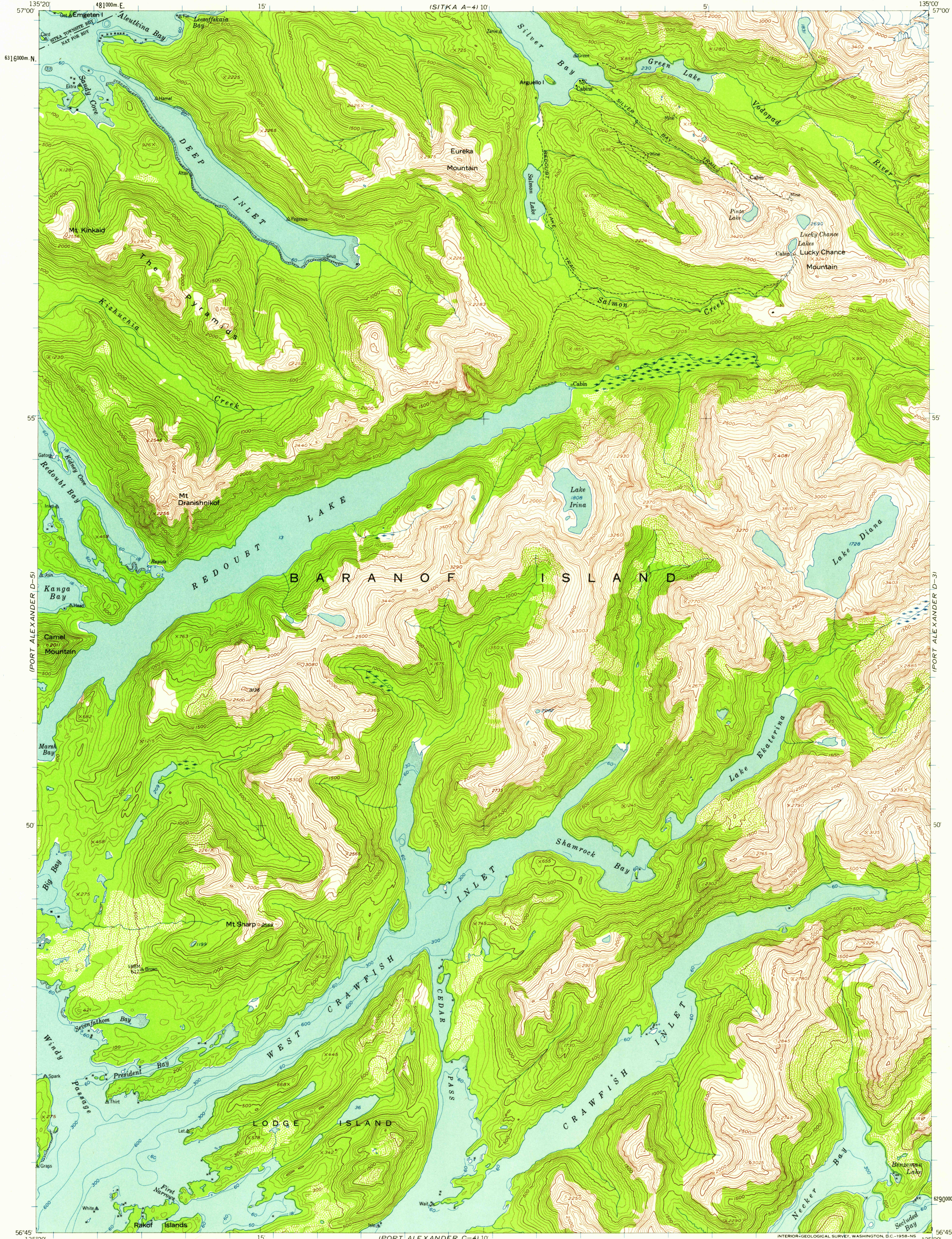

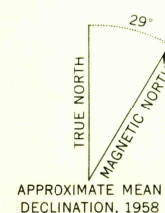
Universal Transverse Mercator projection

1927 North American datum

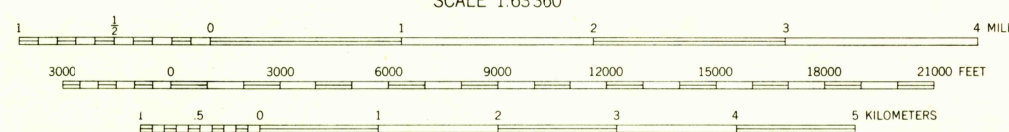
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 8, shown in blue
