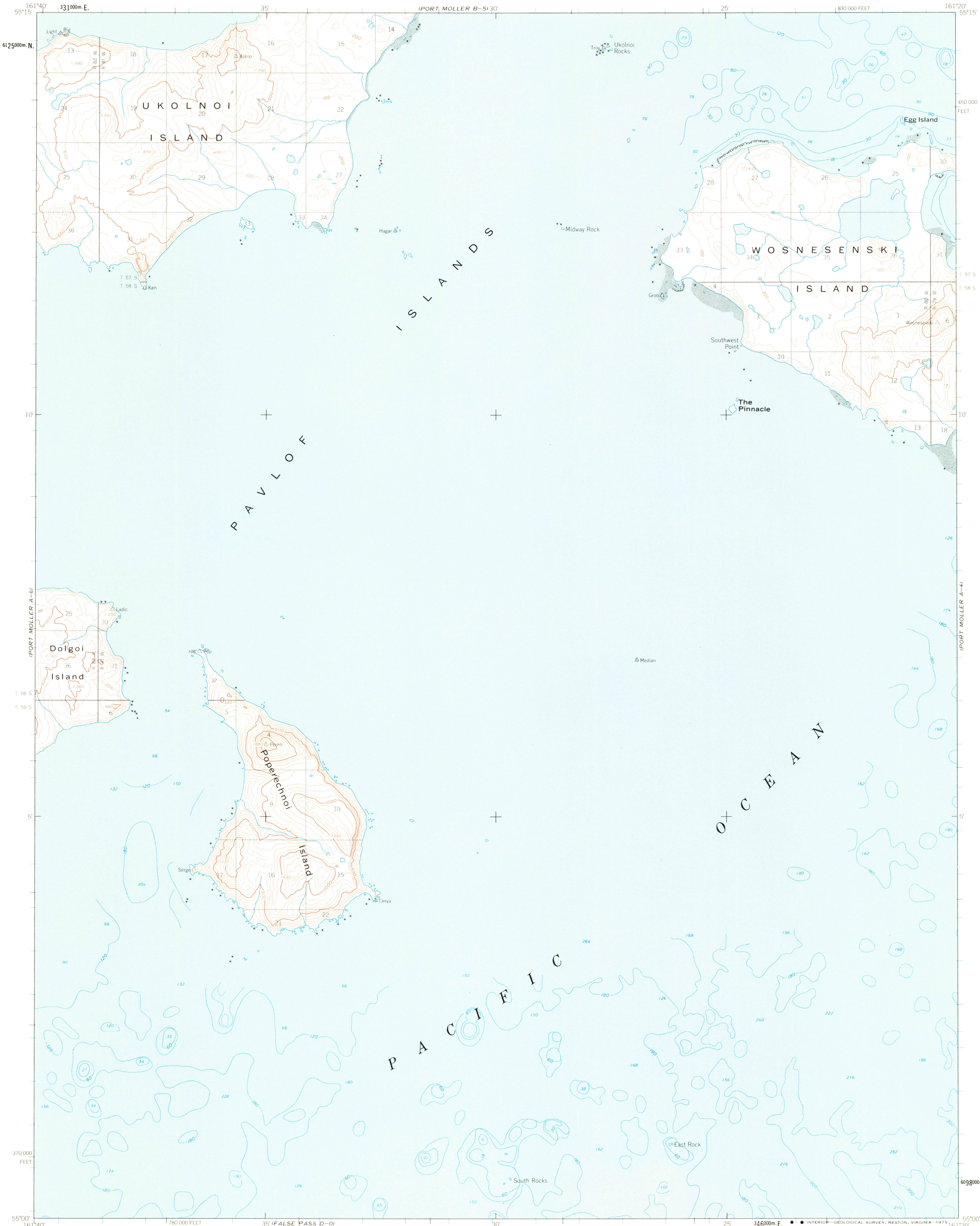

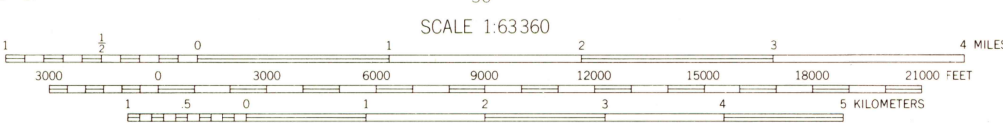
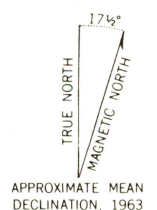
PORT MOLLER (A-5) QUADRANGLE
