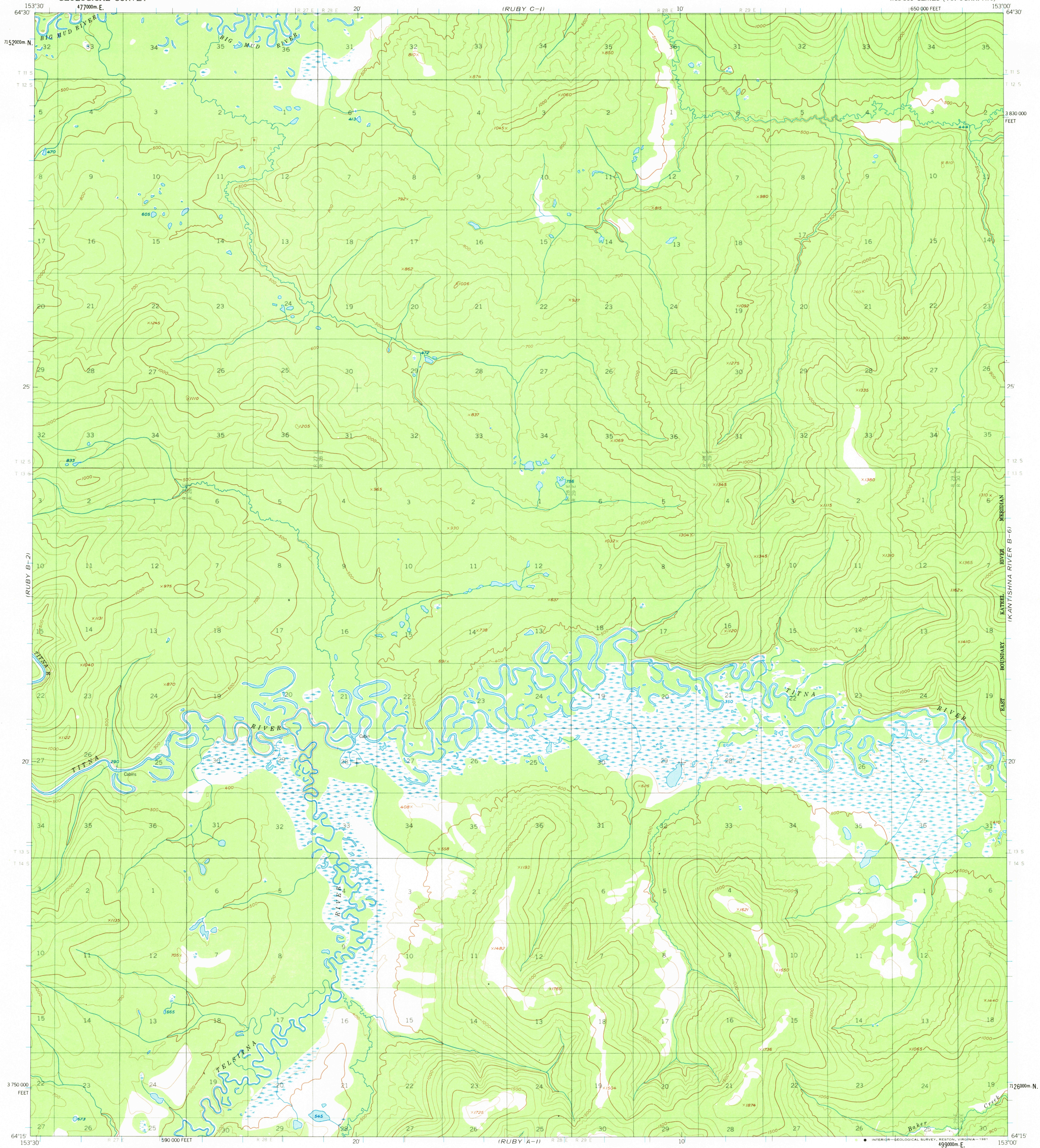

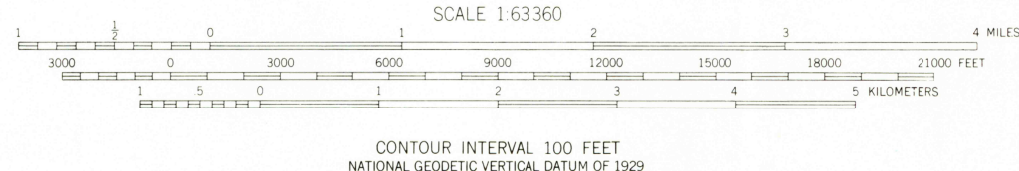
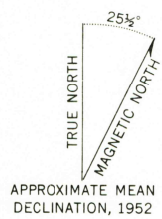
RUBY (B-1) QUADRANGLE
