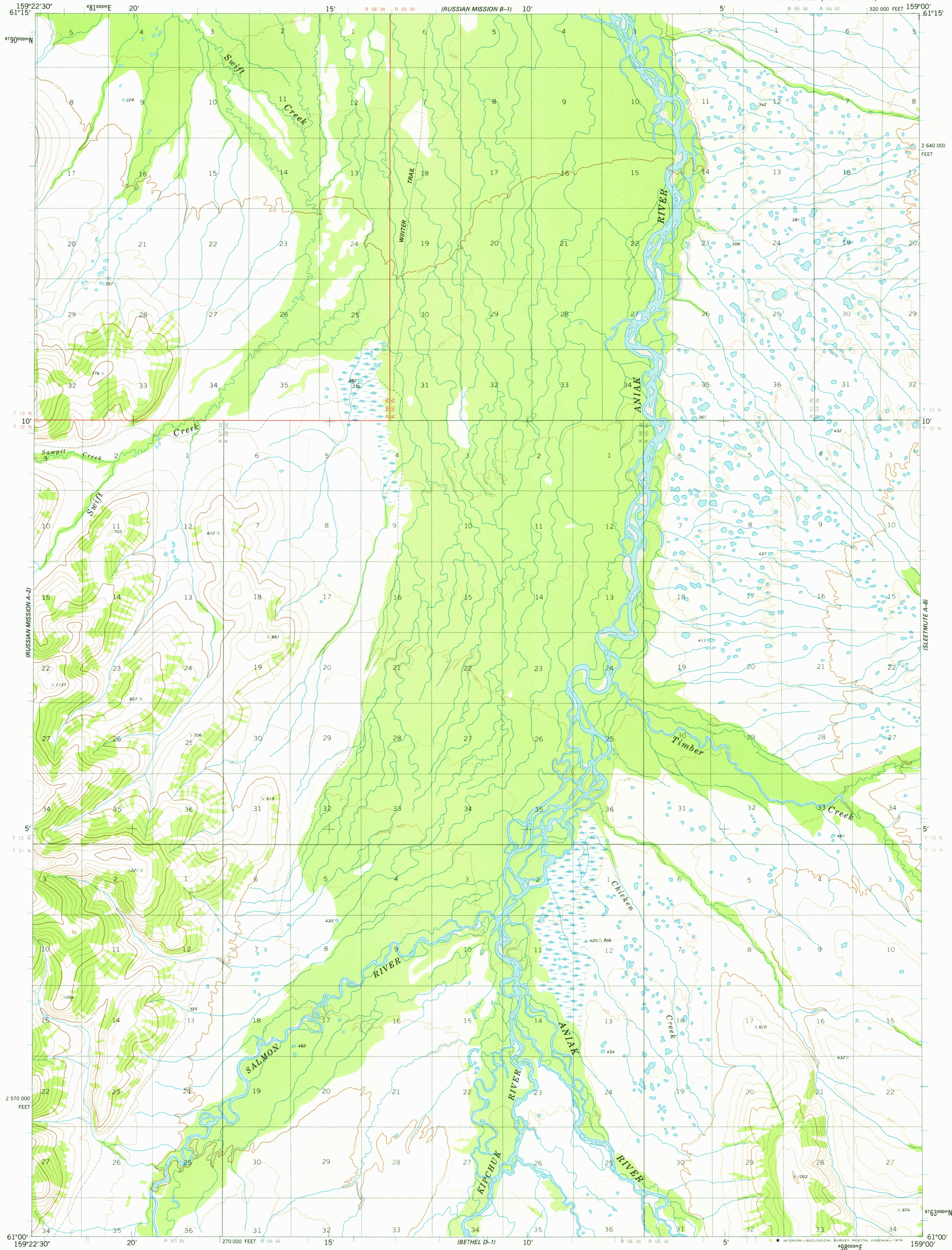

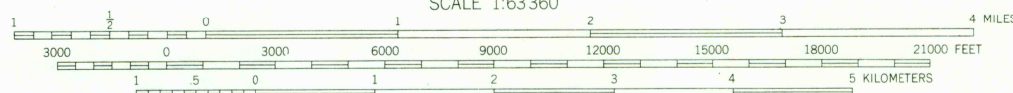
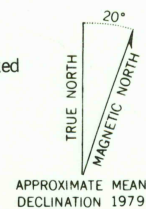


RUSSIAN MISSION (A-1) QUADRANGLE
