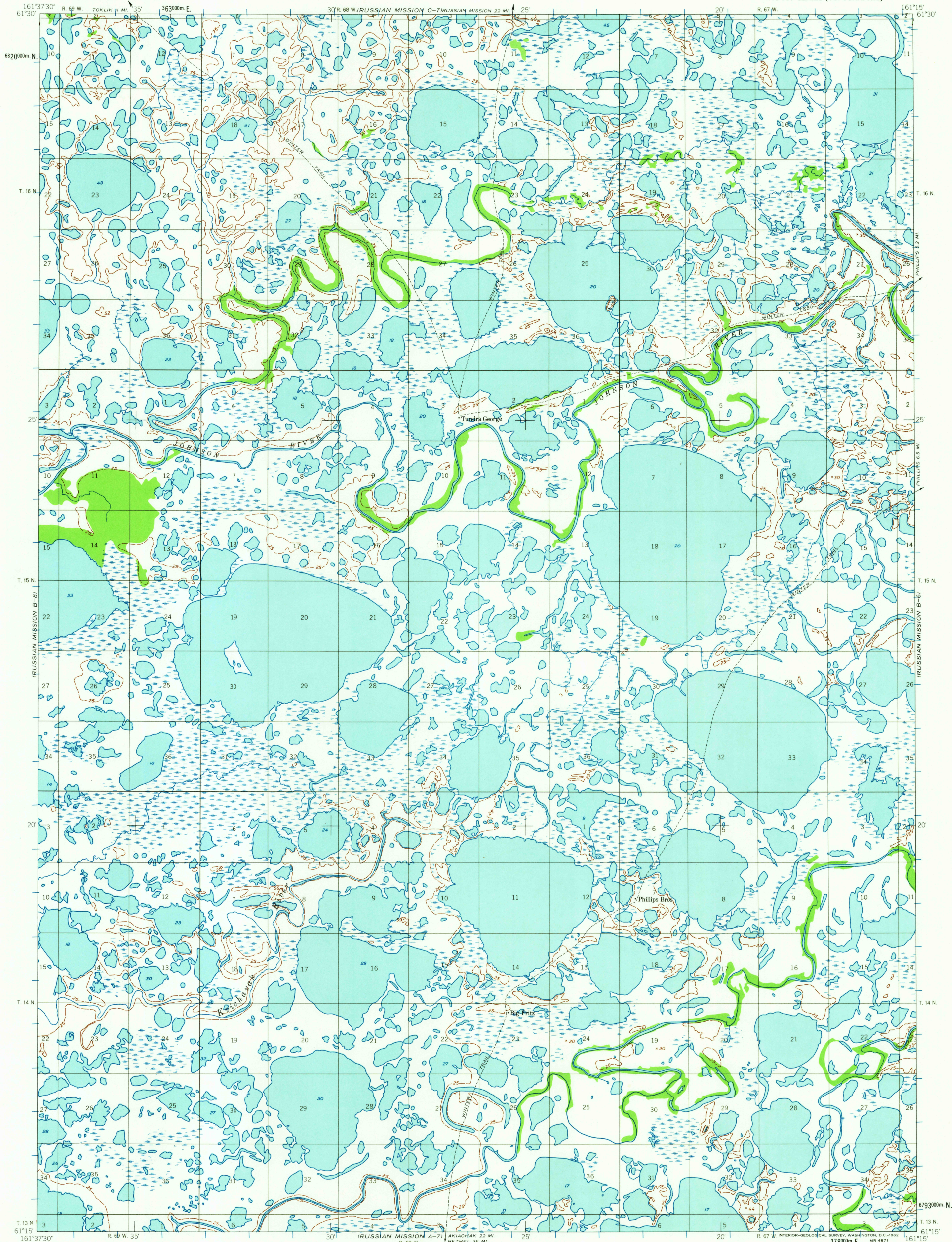

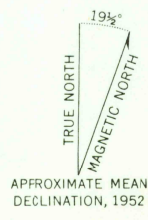

Universal Transverse Mercator projection

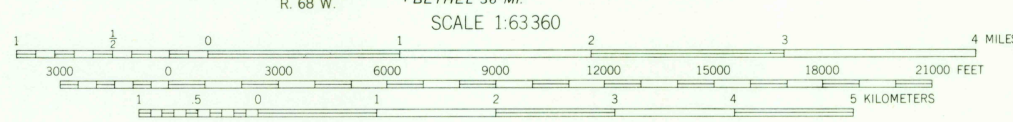
1927 North American datum
