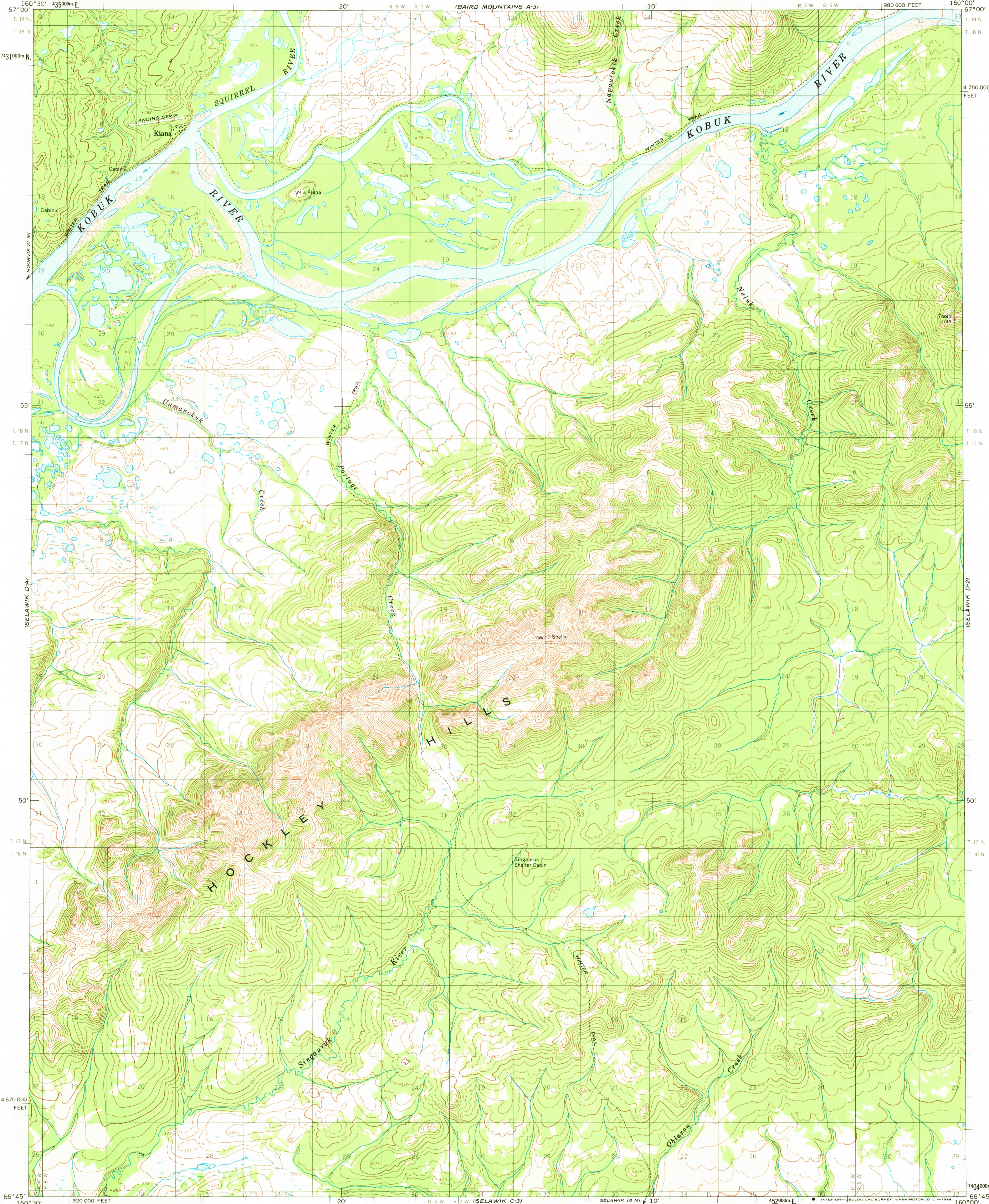

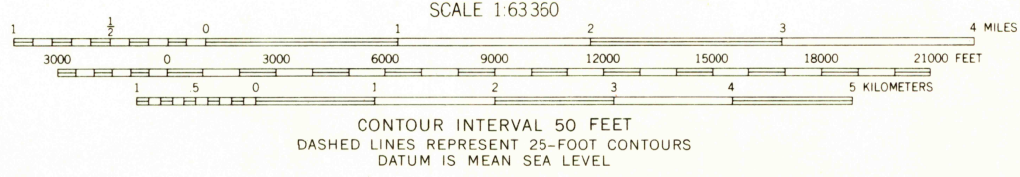
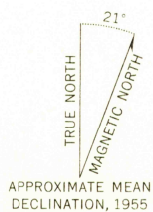
Universal Transverse Mercator projection. 1927 North American datum

10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 7

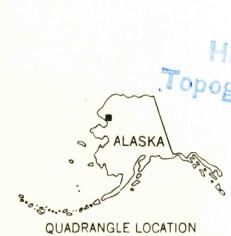
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
