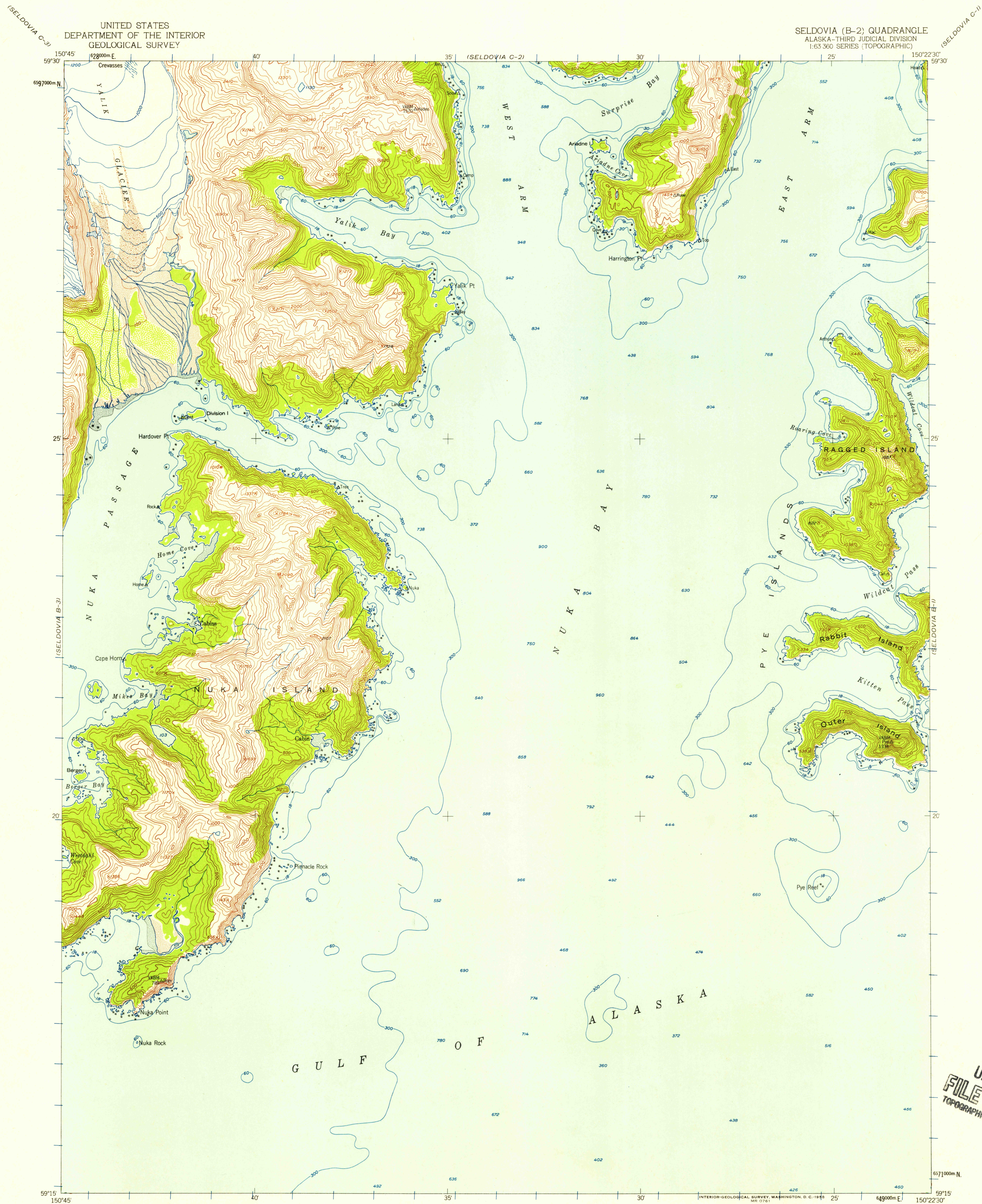

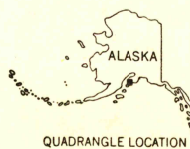
SELDOVIA (B-2) QUADRANGLE
