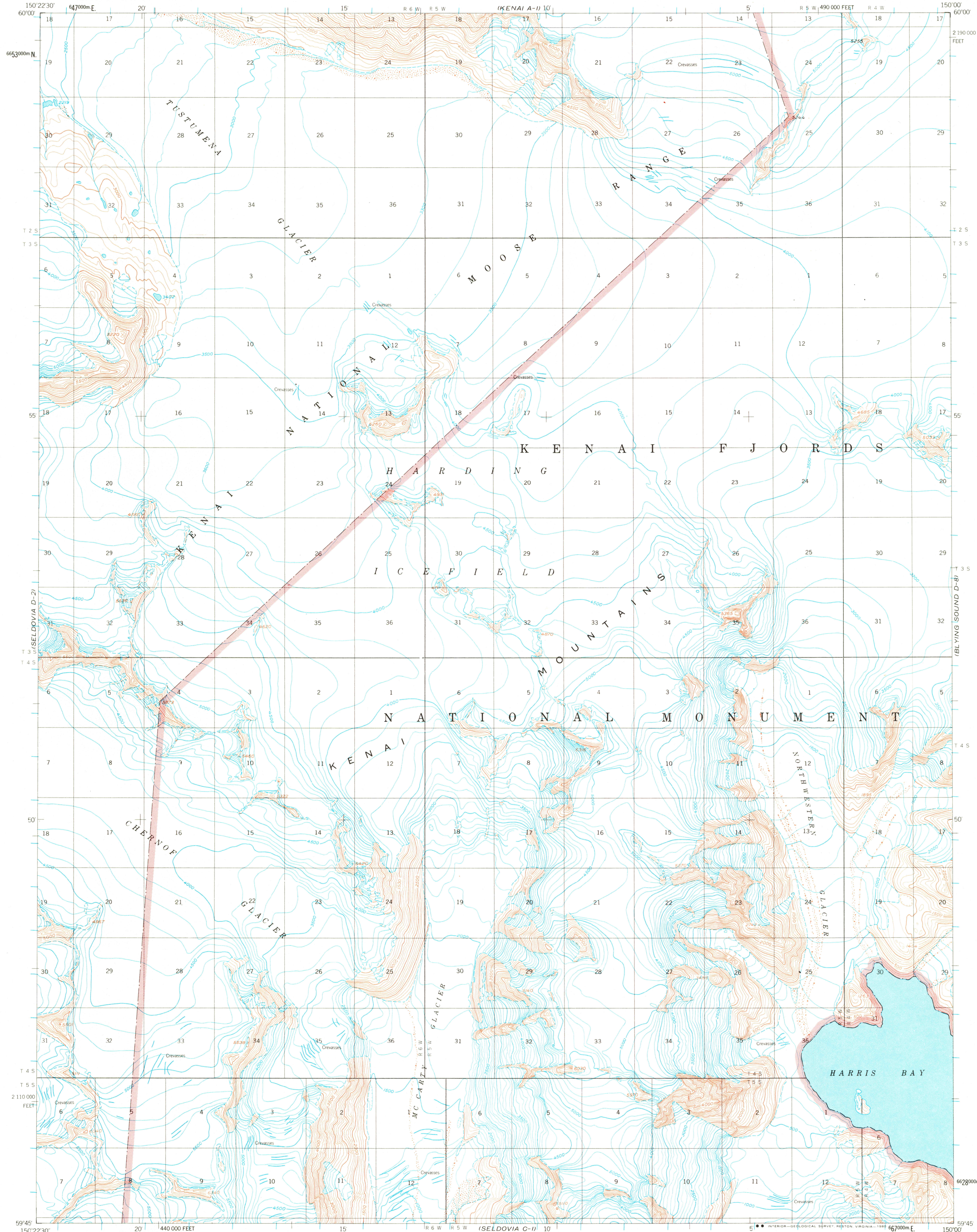

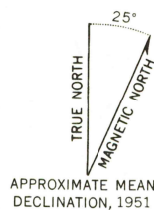

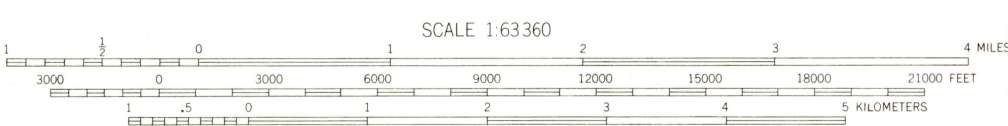
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-16, Seward Meridian
