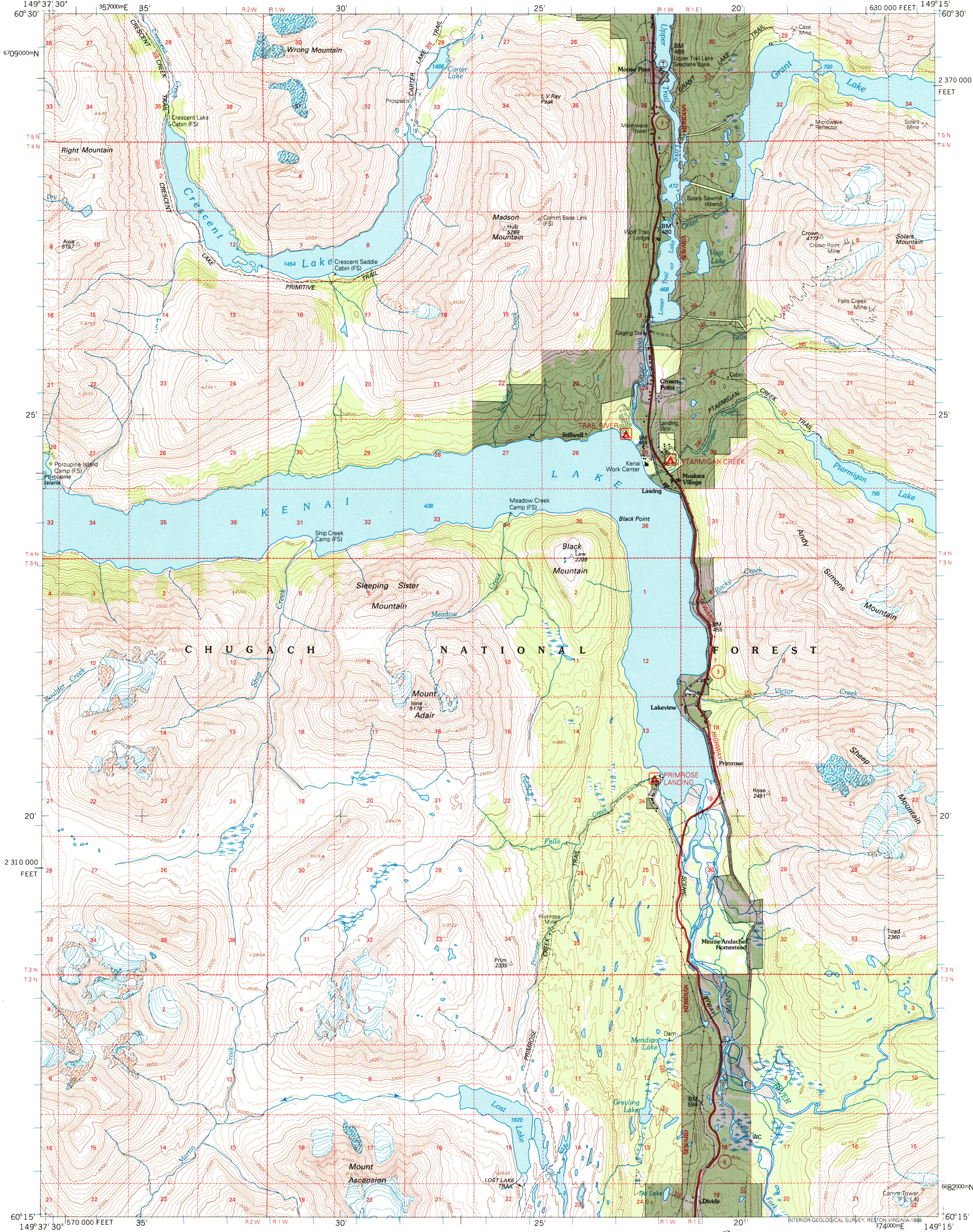

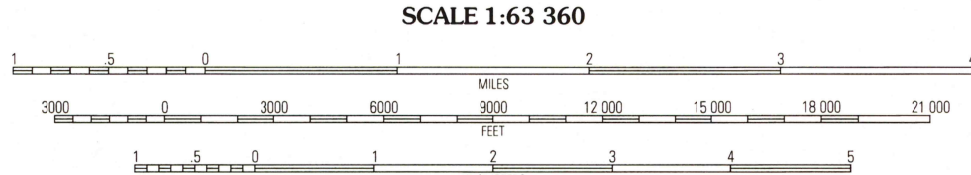
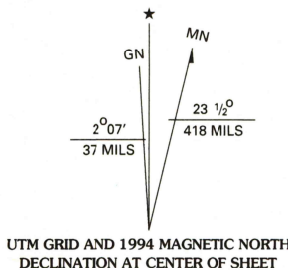
North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27). Projection and 10 000-foot ticks: Alaska coordinate system, zone 4 (Transverse Mercator).
