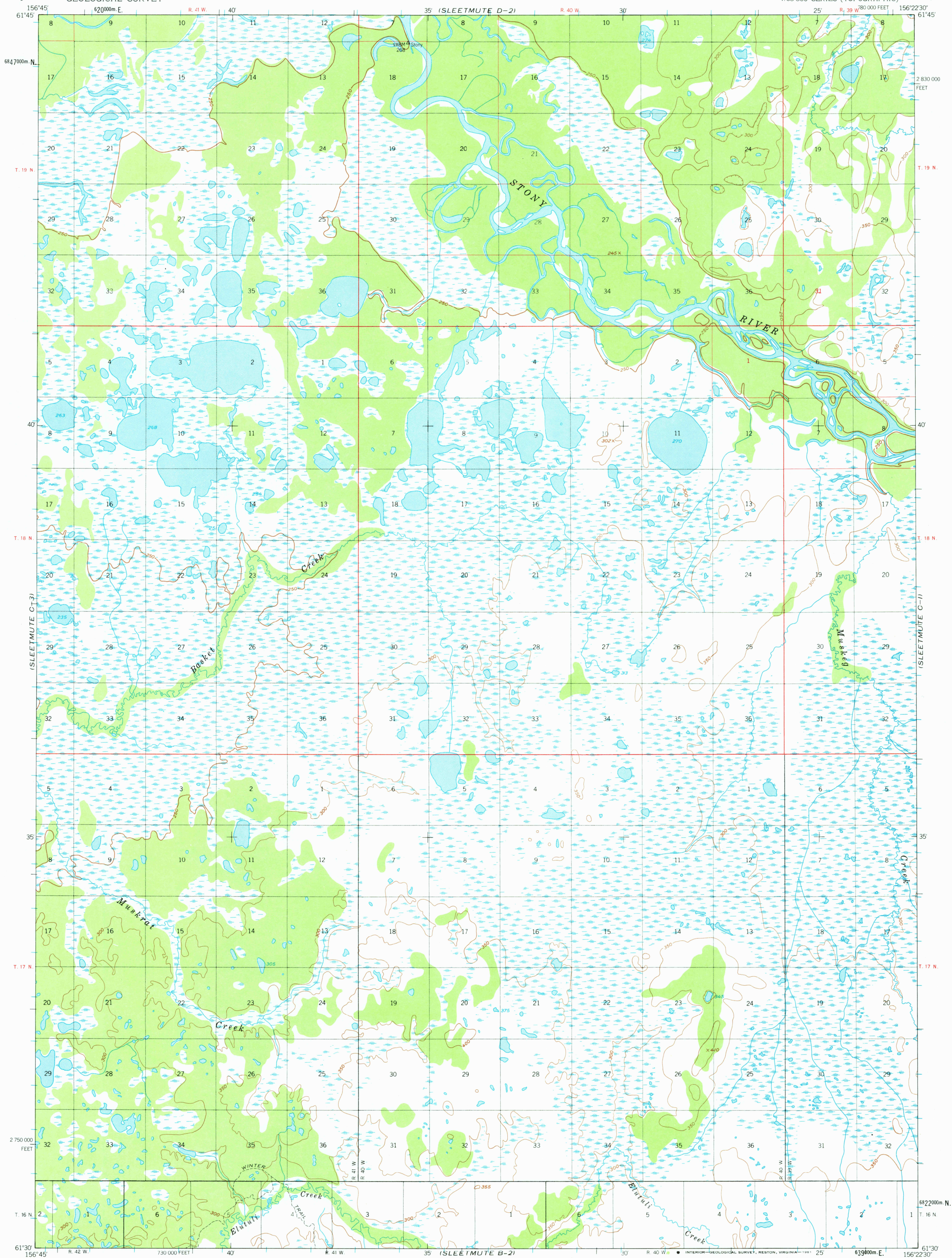

Folios S-4 and S-11, Seward Meridian

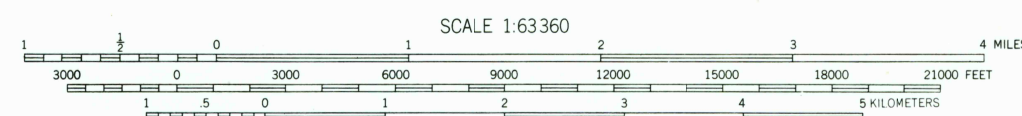
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
