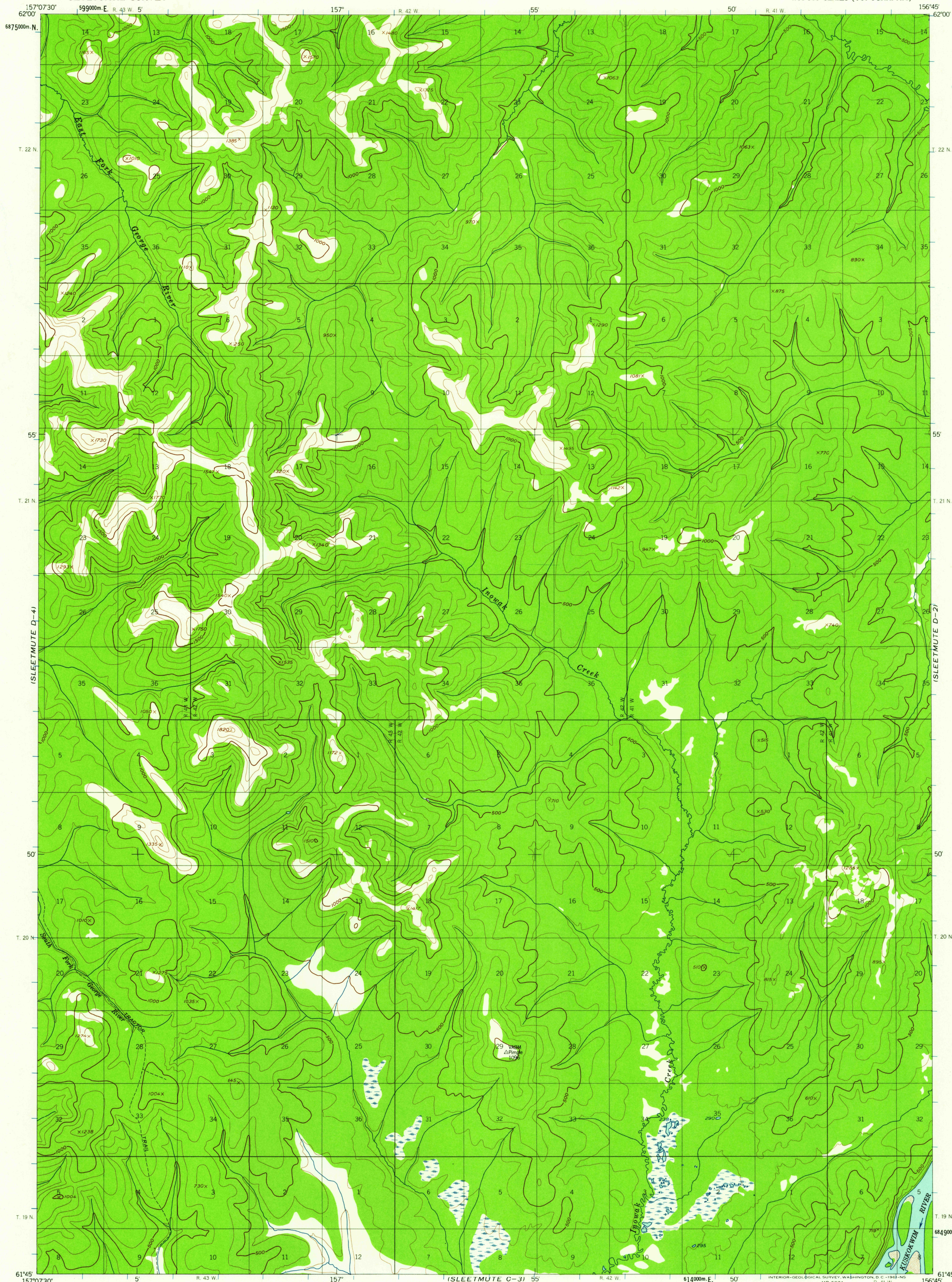

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 4, shown in blue

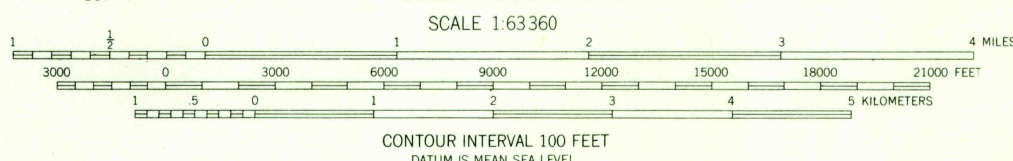
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations

usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs

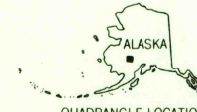
