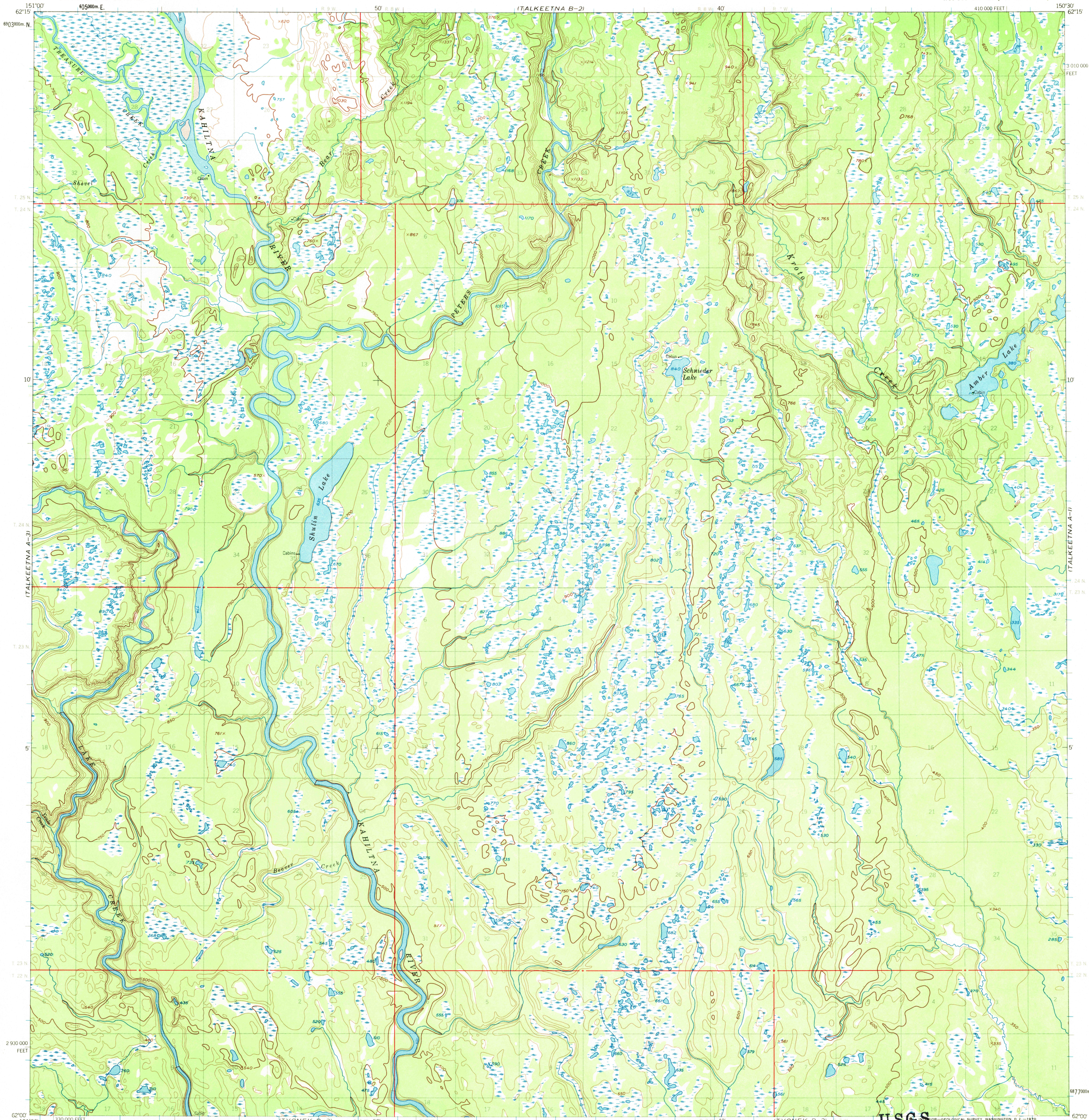

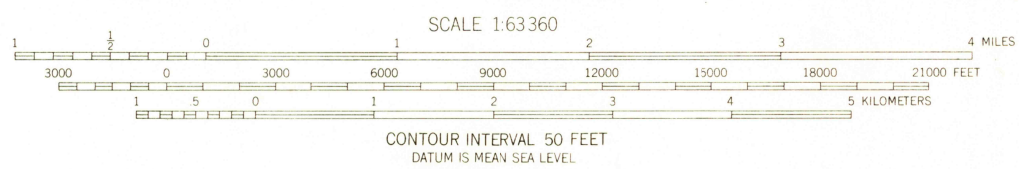
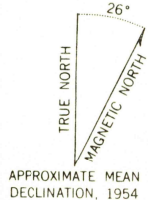
TALKEETNA (A-2) QUADRANGLE
