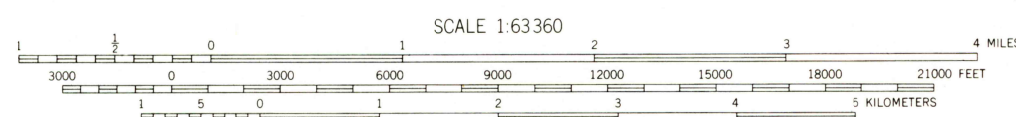


Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1948, field annotated 1949. Map not field checked

Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folios S-1, Seward Meridian and CR-4, Copper River Meridian Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 58 meters north and 115 meters east



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
