

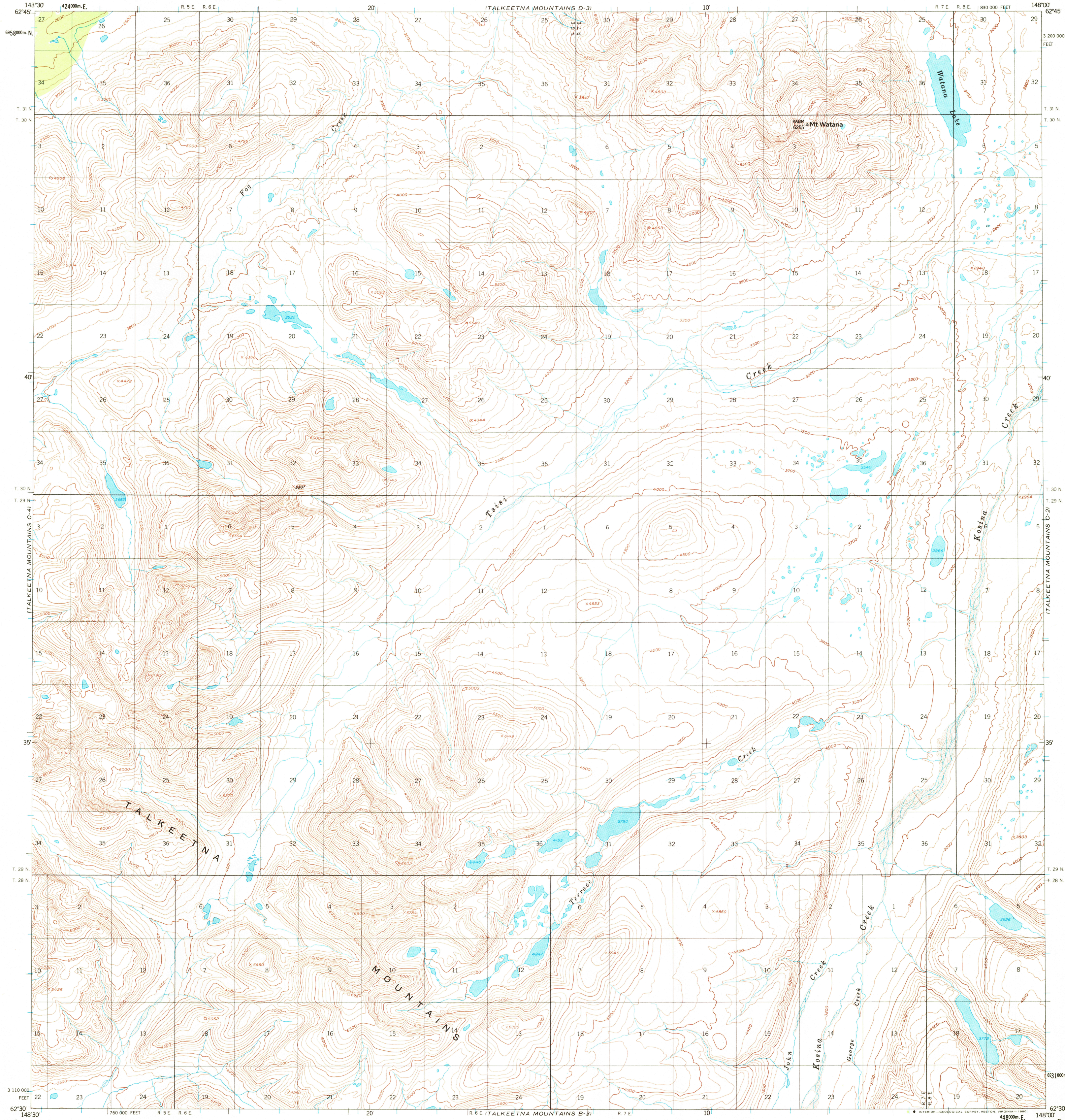

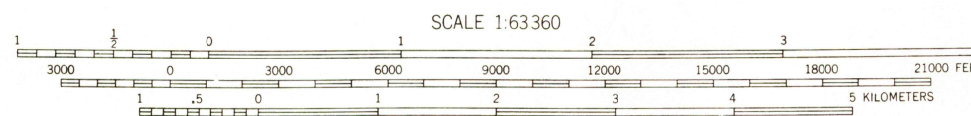
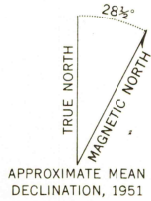


TALKEETNA MOUNTAINS (C-3) QUADRANGLE
