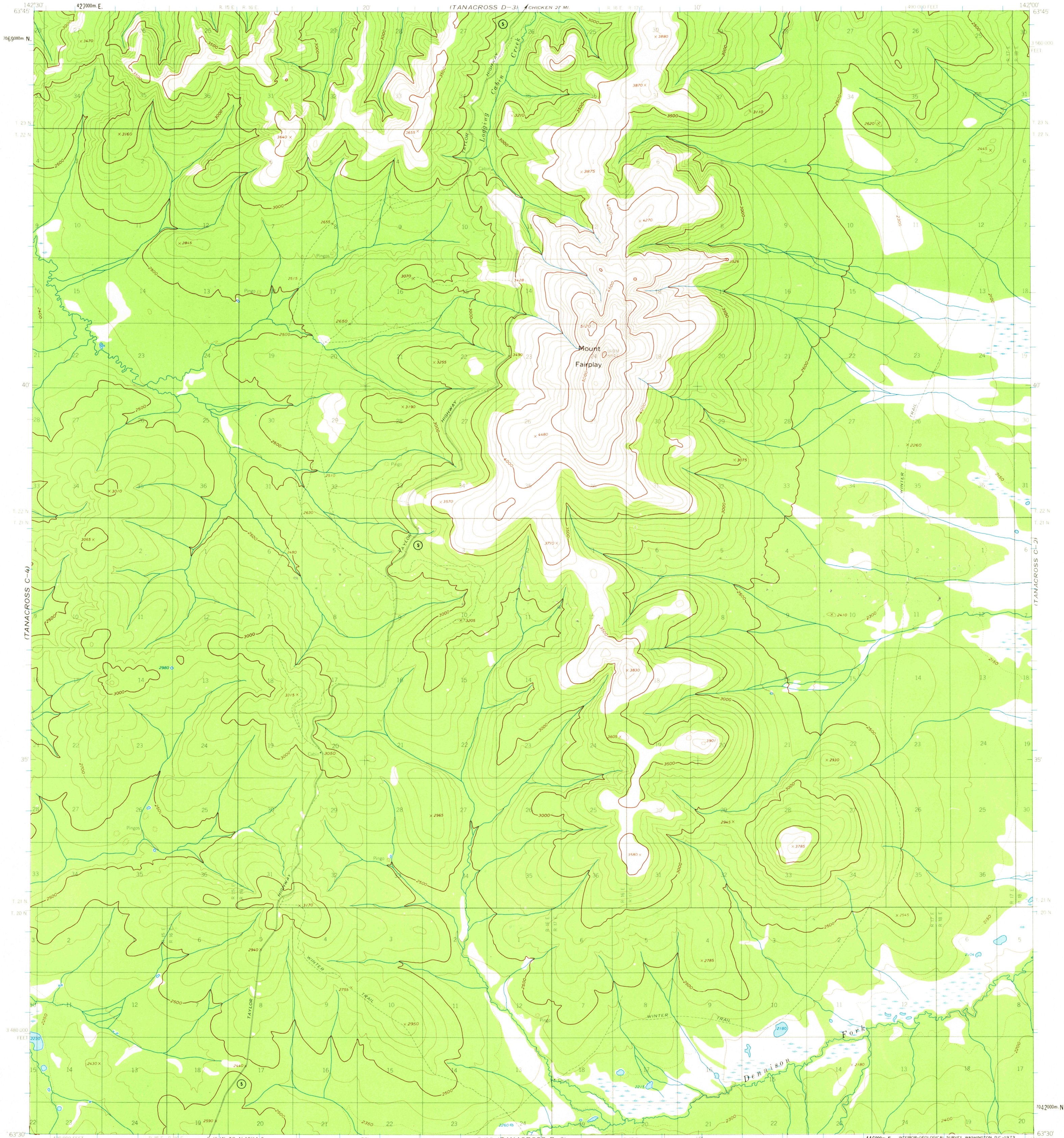

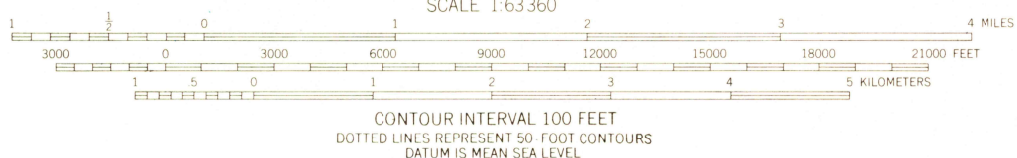
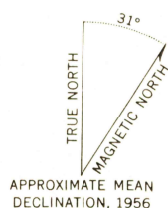
TANACROSS (C-3) QUADRANGLE
