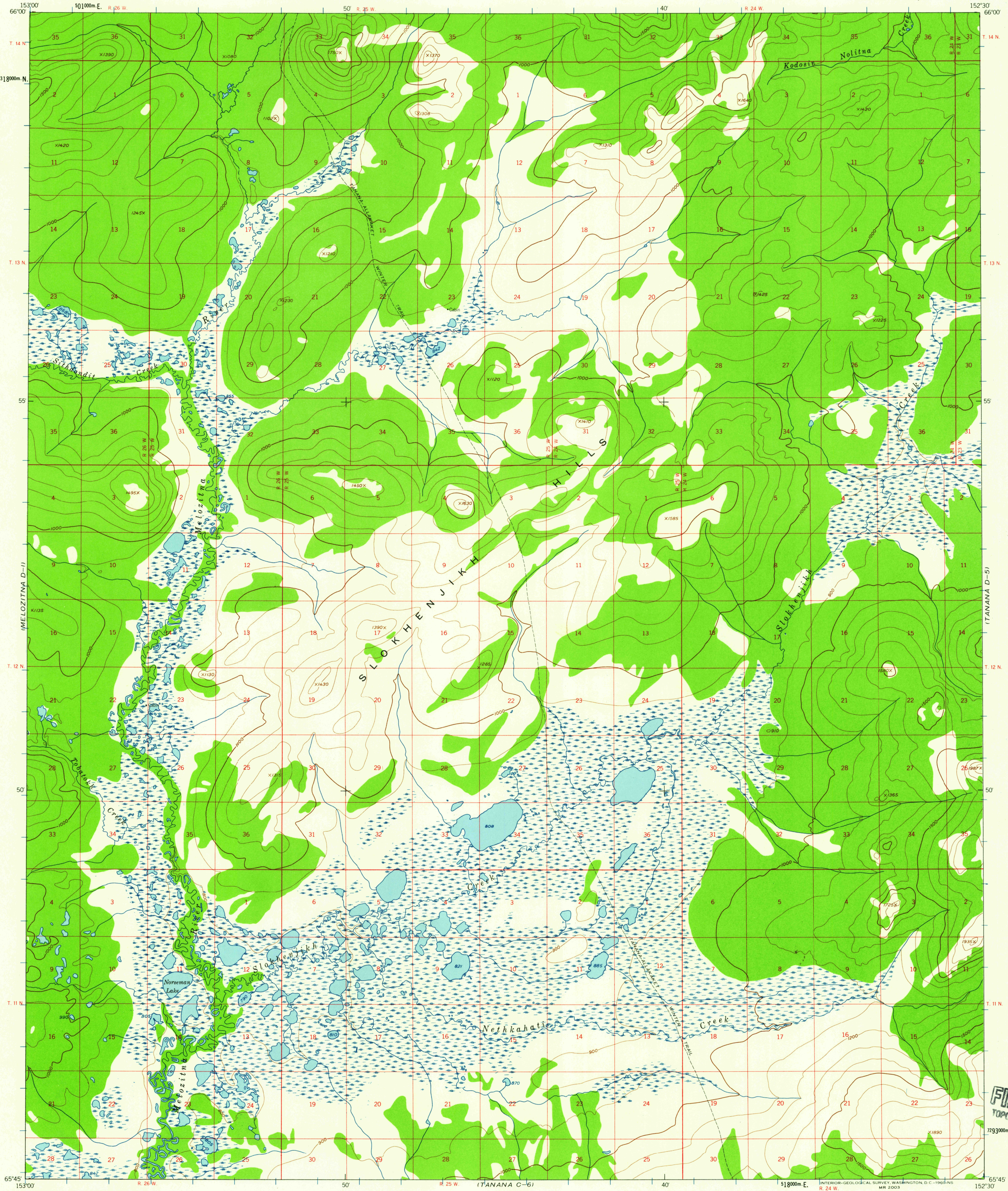

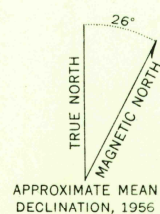

zone 5, shown in blue

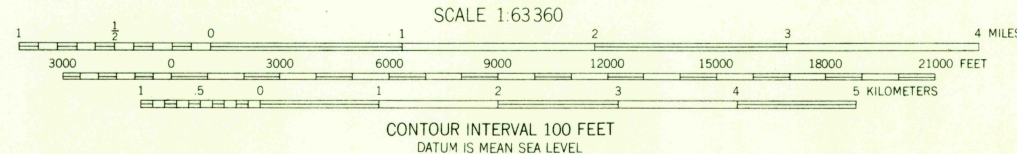
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations

Unchecked elevations are shown in brown and blue



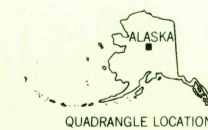
APPROXIMATE MEAN
