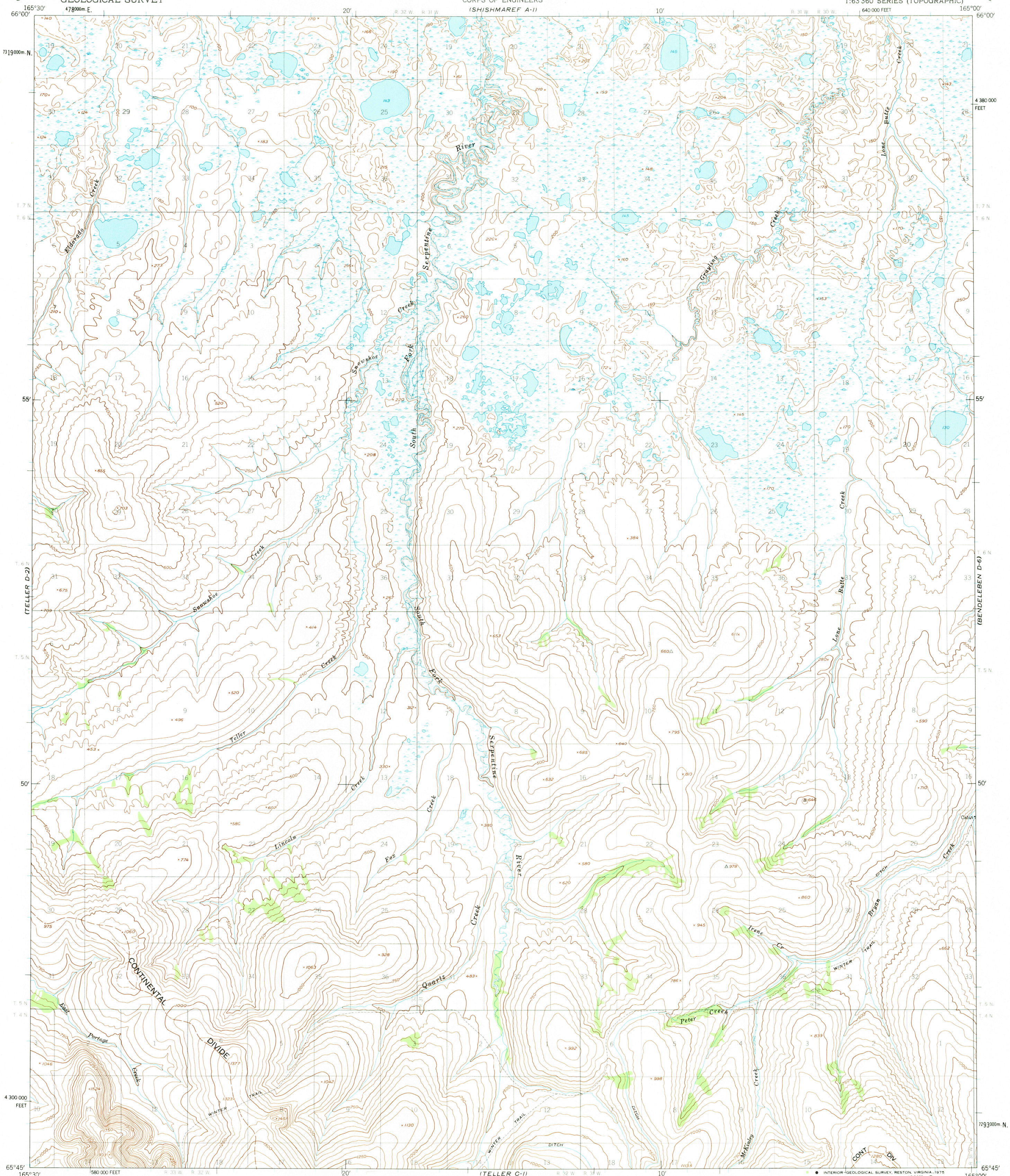

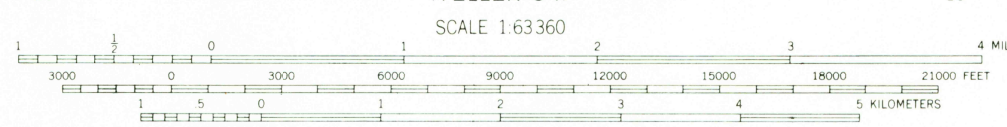
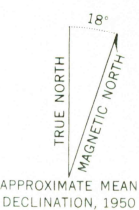
TELLER (D-1) QUADRANGLE
