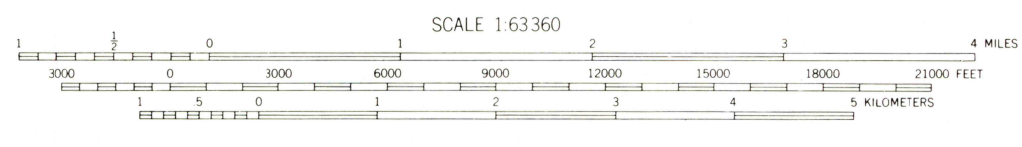
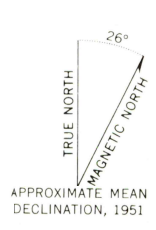
TYONEK (A-1) QUADRANGLE
