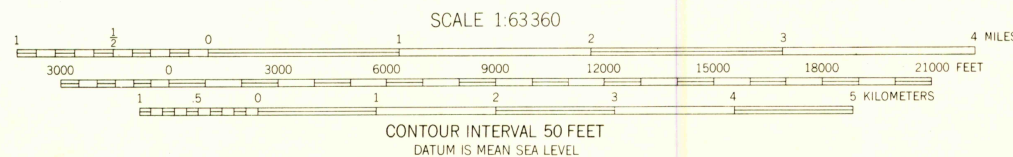
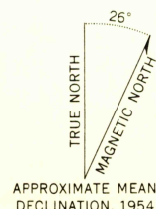

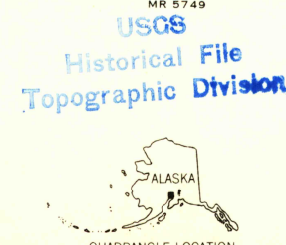
TYONEK (D-2) QUADRANGLE
