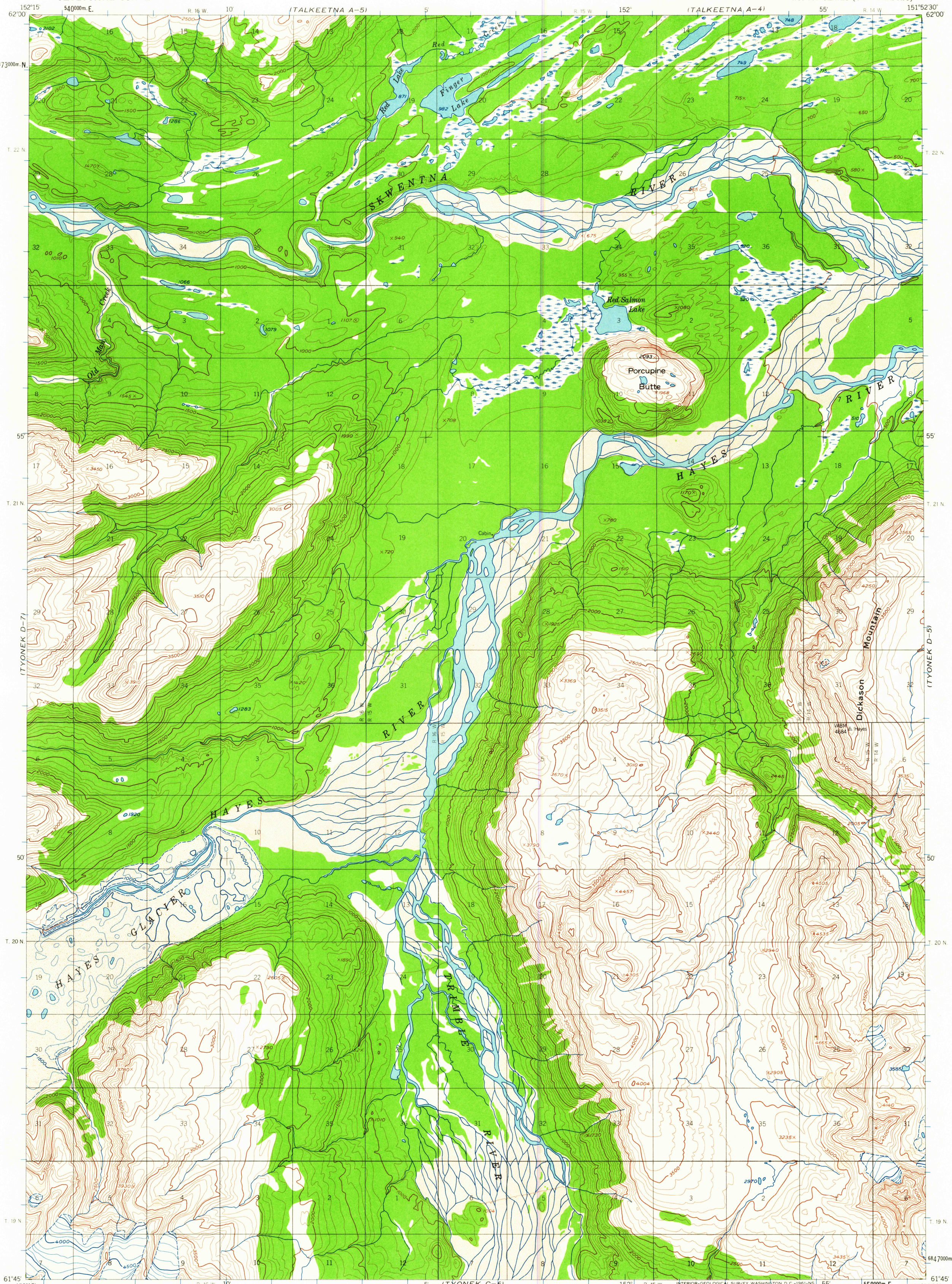

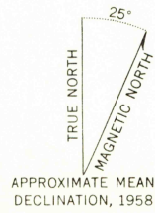

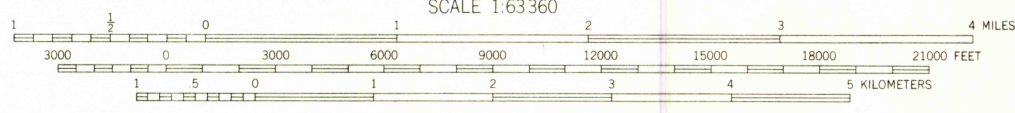
Universal Transverse Mercator projection
