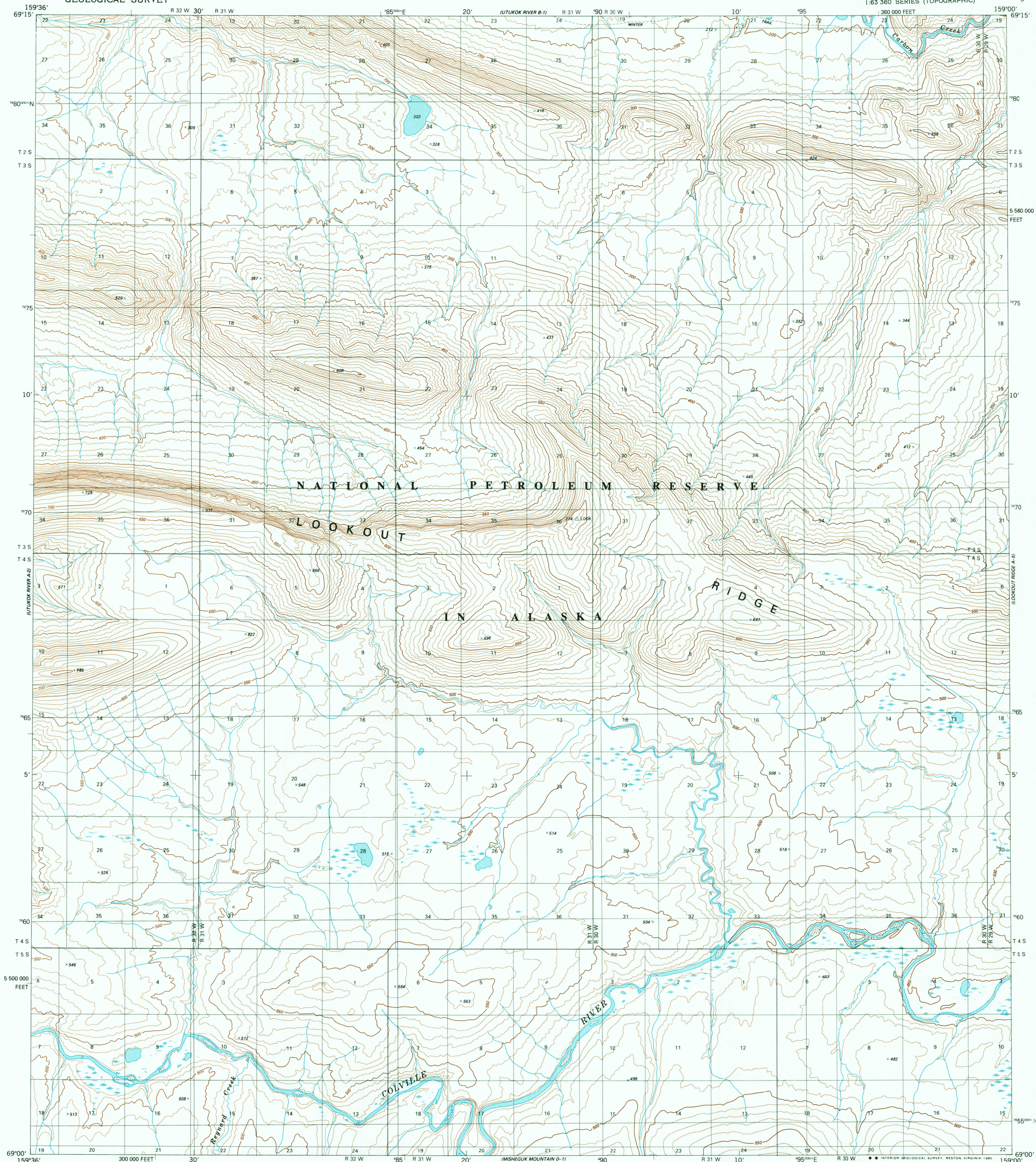
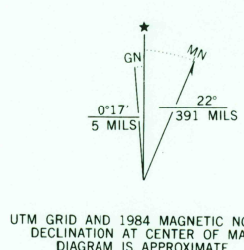

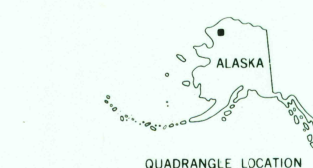
UTUKOK RIVER (A-1) QUADRANGLE
