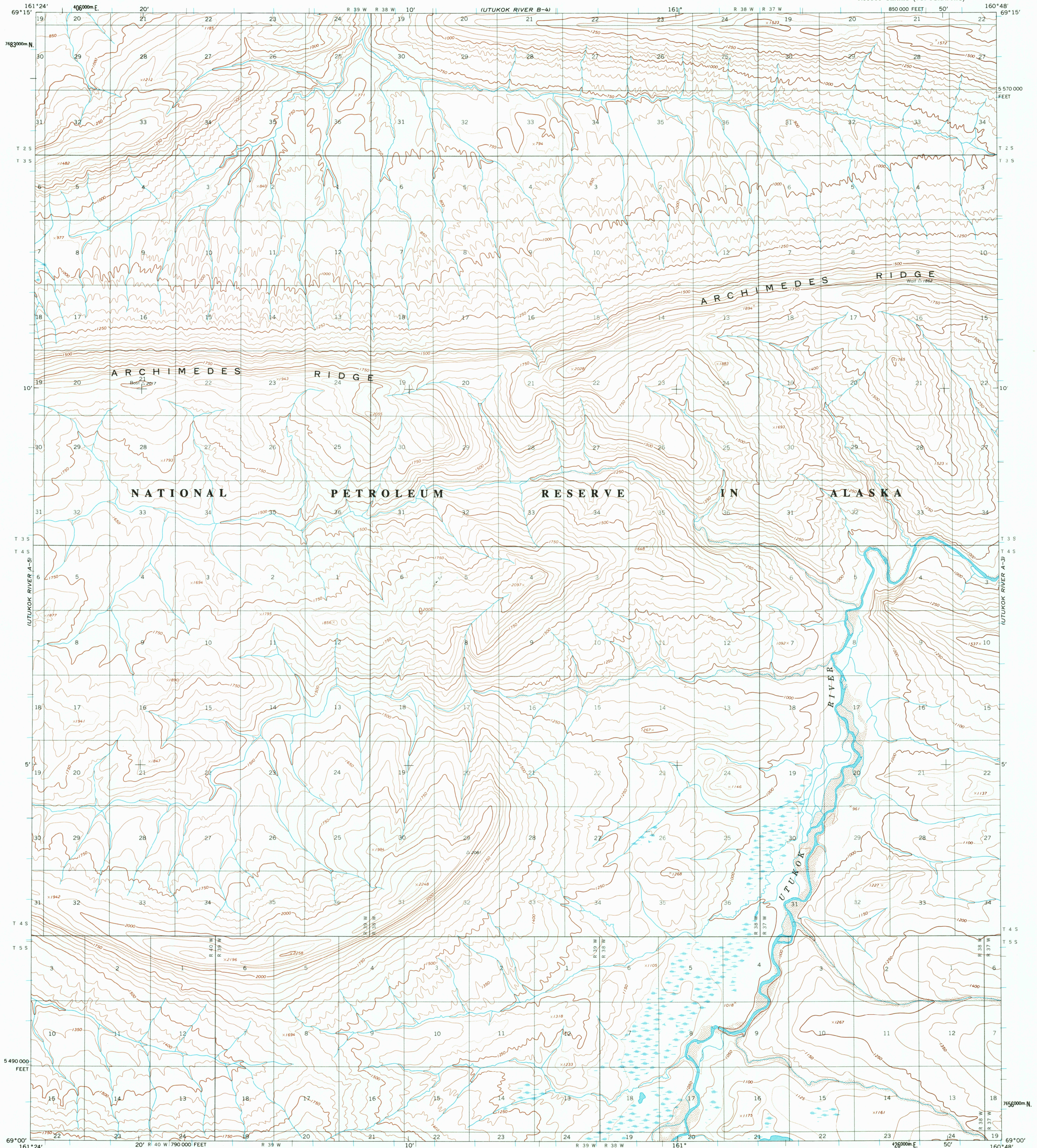

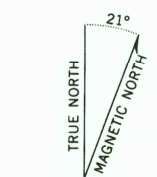

Foio U-8, Umat Meridian

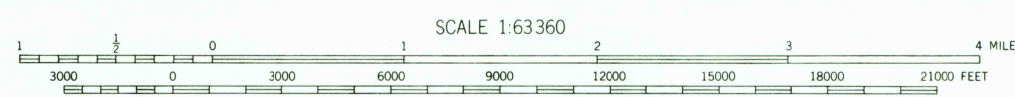
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
