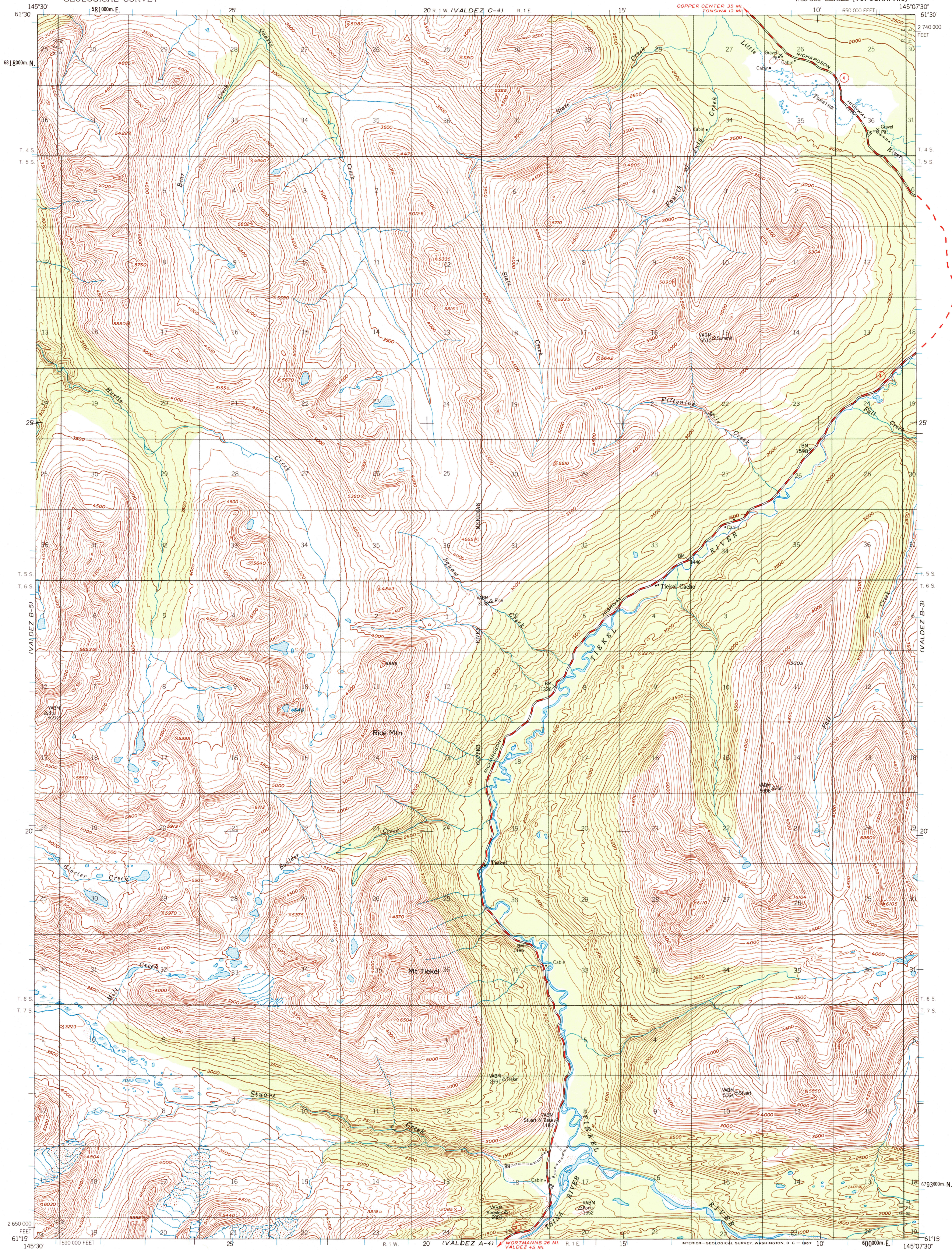

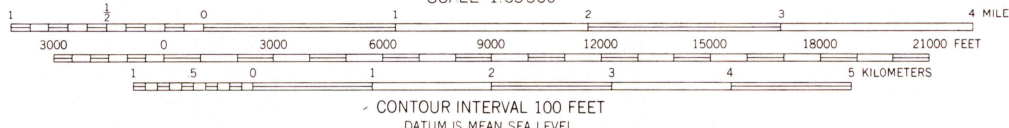
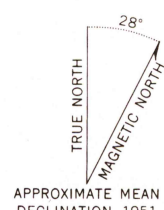
VALDEZ (B-4) QUADRANGLE
