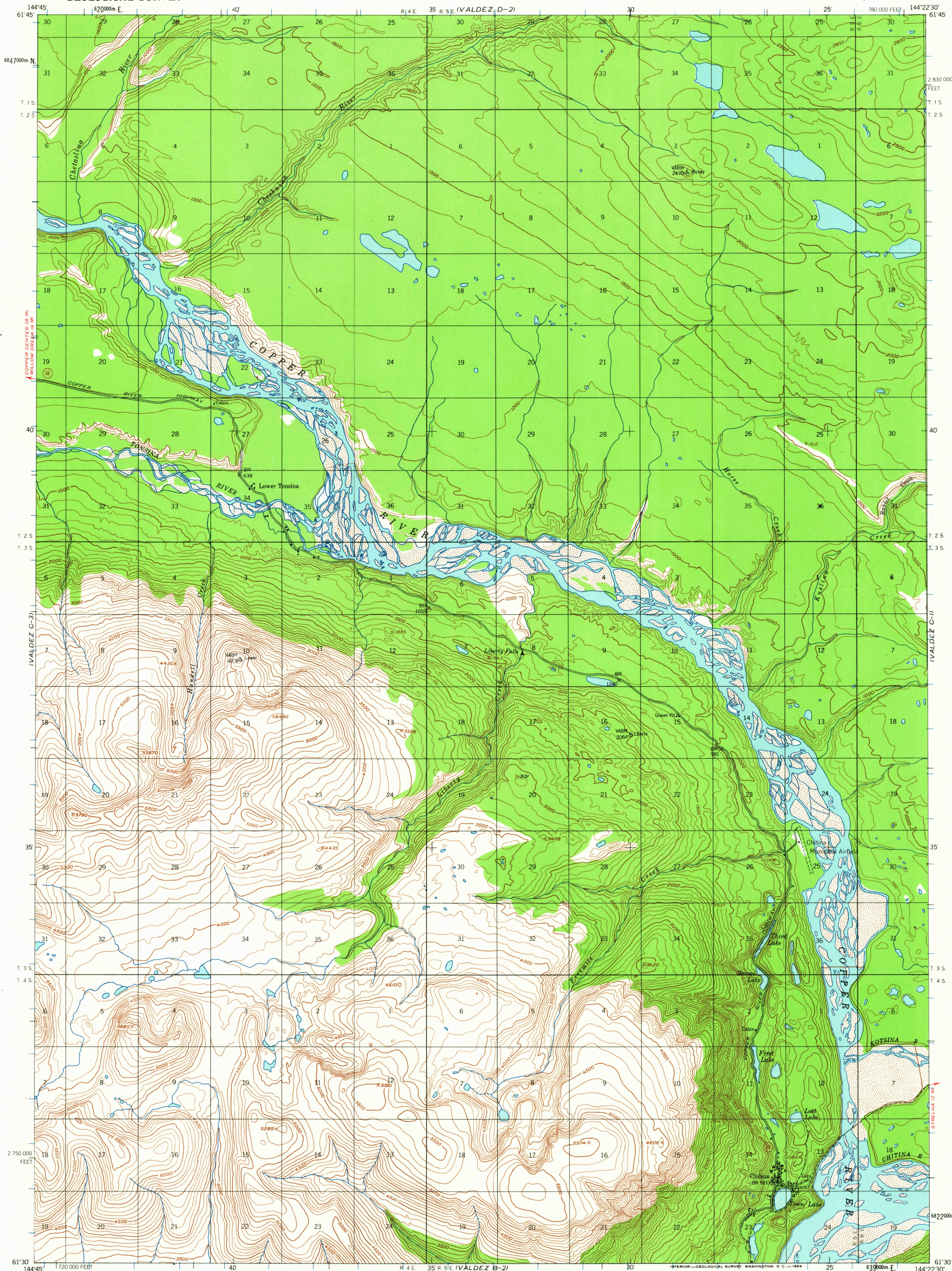

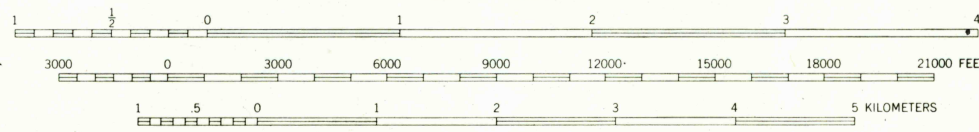
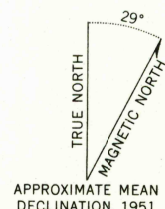
VALDEZ (C-2) QUADRANGLE
