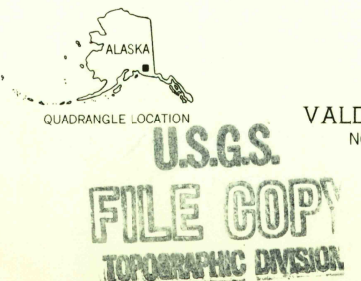
VALDEZ (D-3) QUADRANGLE
