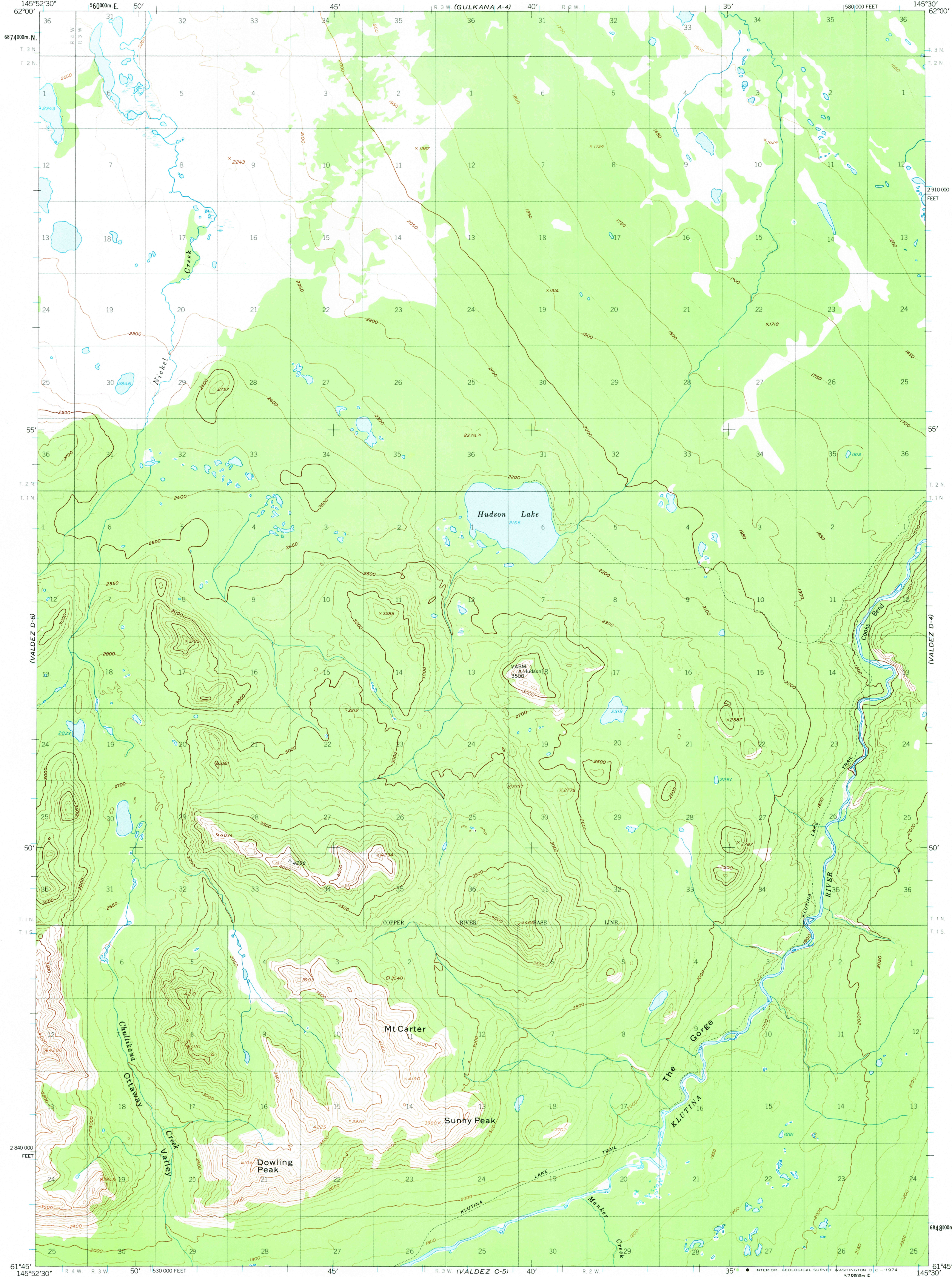

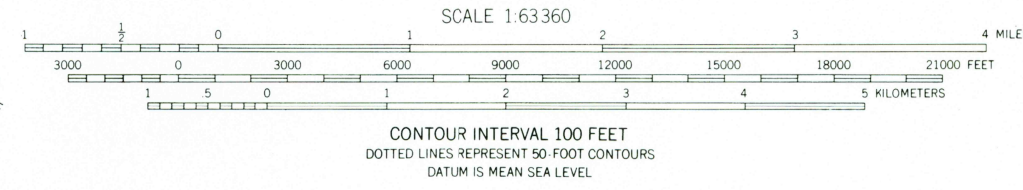
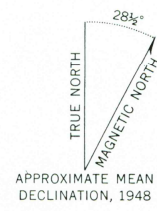
VALDEZ (D-5) QUADRANGLE
