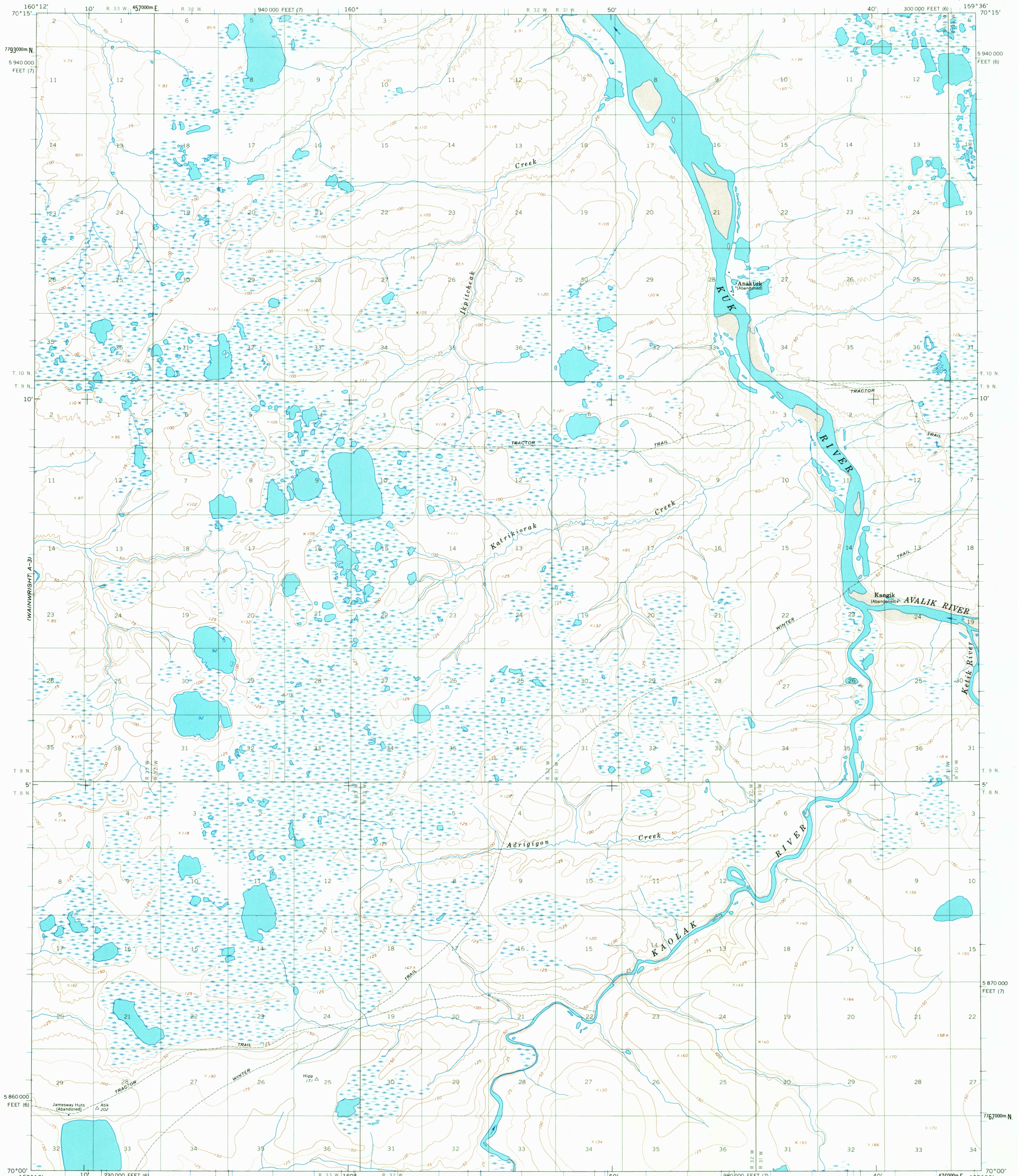


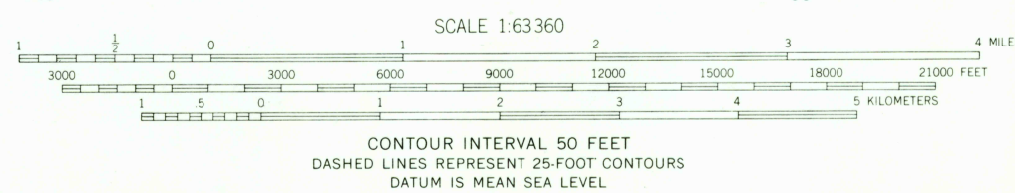
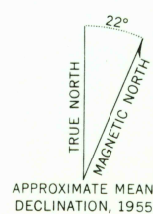

Entire area lies within Naval Petroleum Reserve No. 4

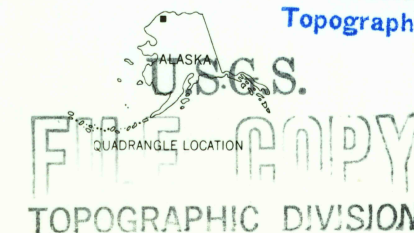
