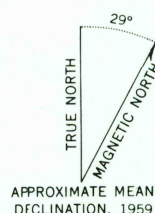

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio CR-8, Copper River Meridian

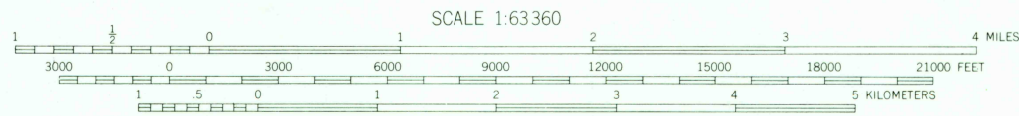
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
