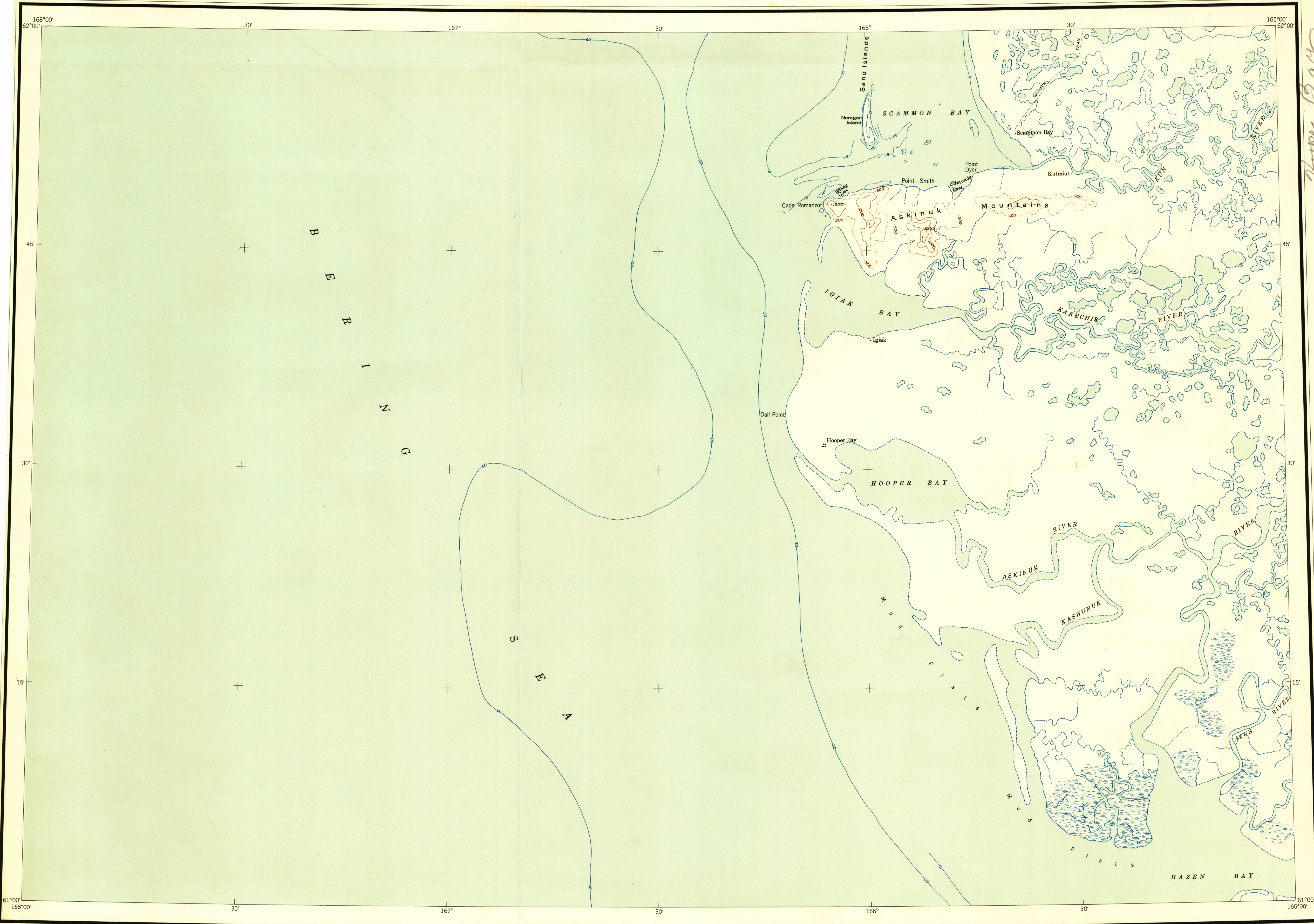
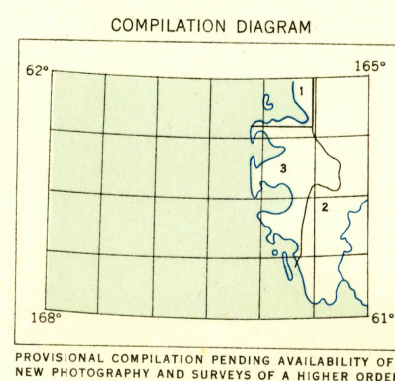


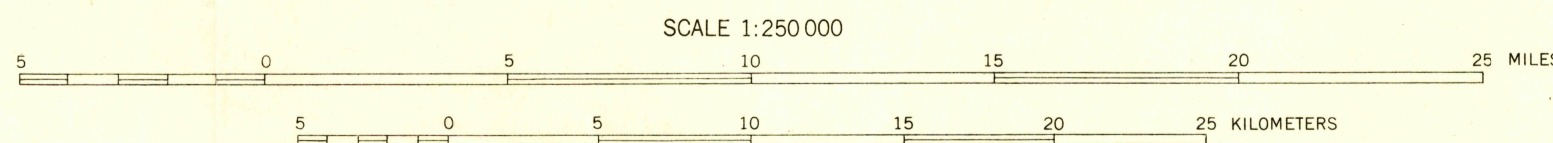

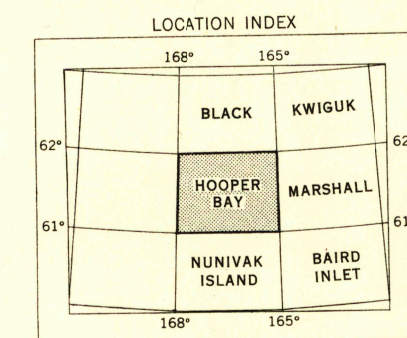
1. PLANIMETRY FROM US&GS CHART 9370
