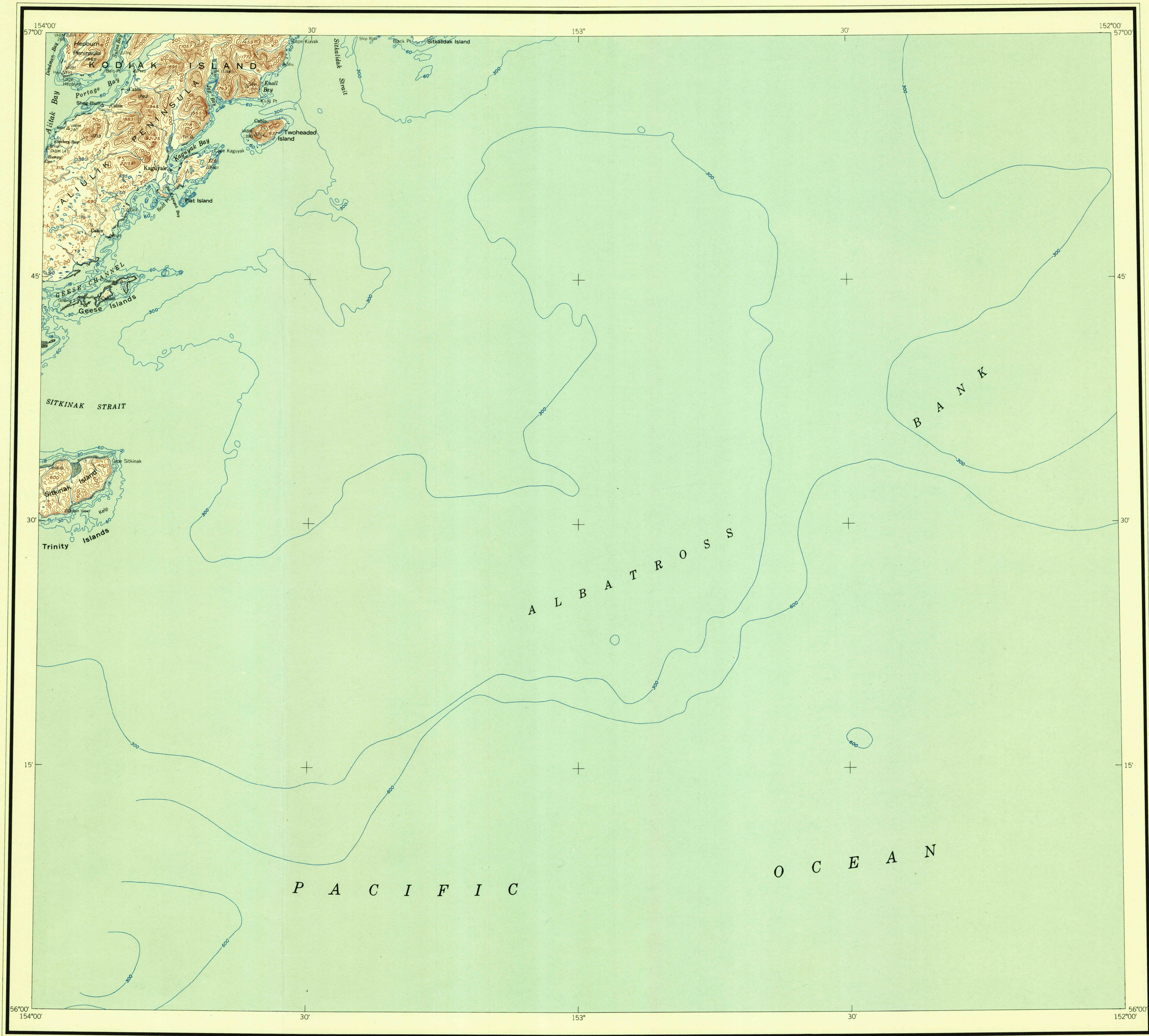

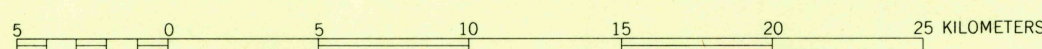
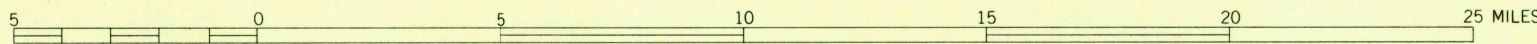

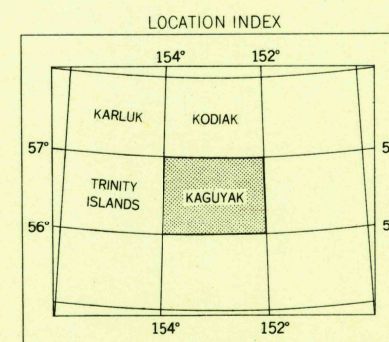
1955 MAGNETIC DECLINATION AT SOUTH EDGE OF SHEET VARIES FROM 34° TO 36° EAST
