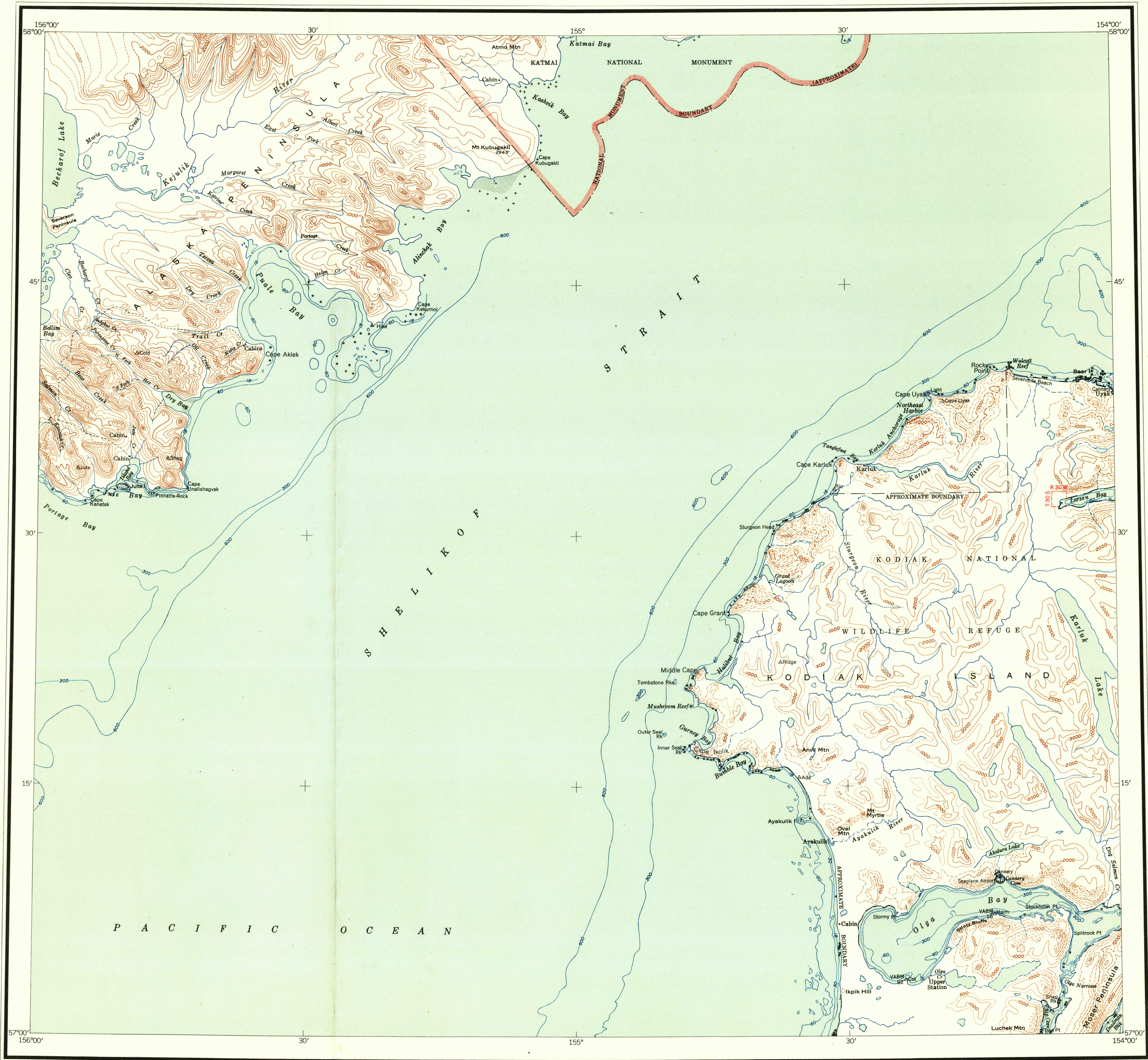

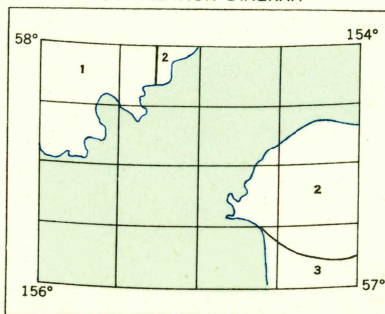

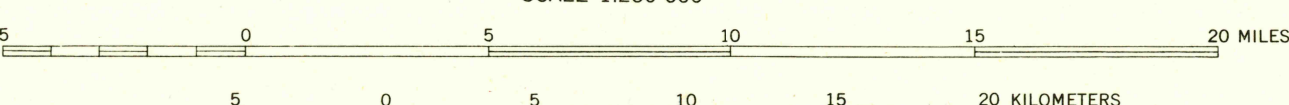

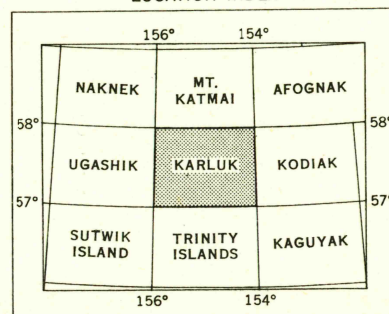


CONTOUR INTERVALS 200, 250, AND 1000 FEET
