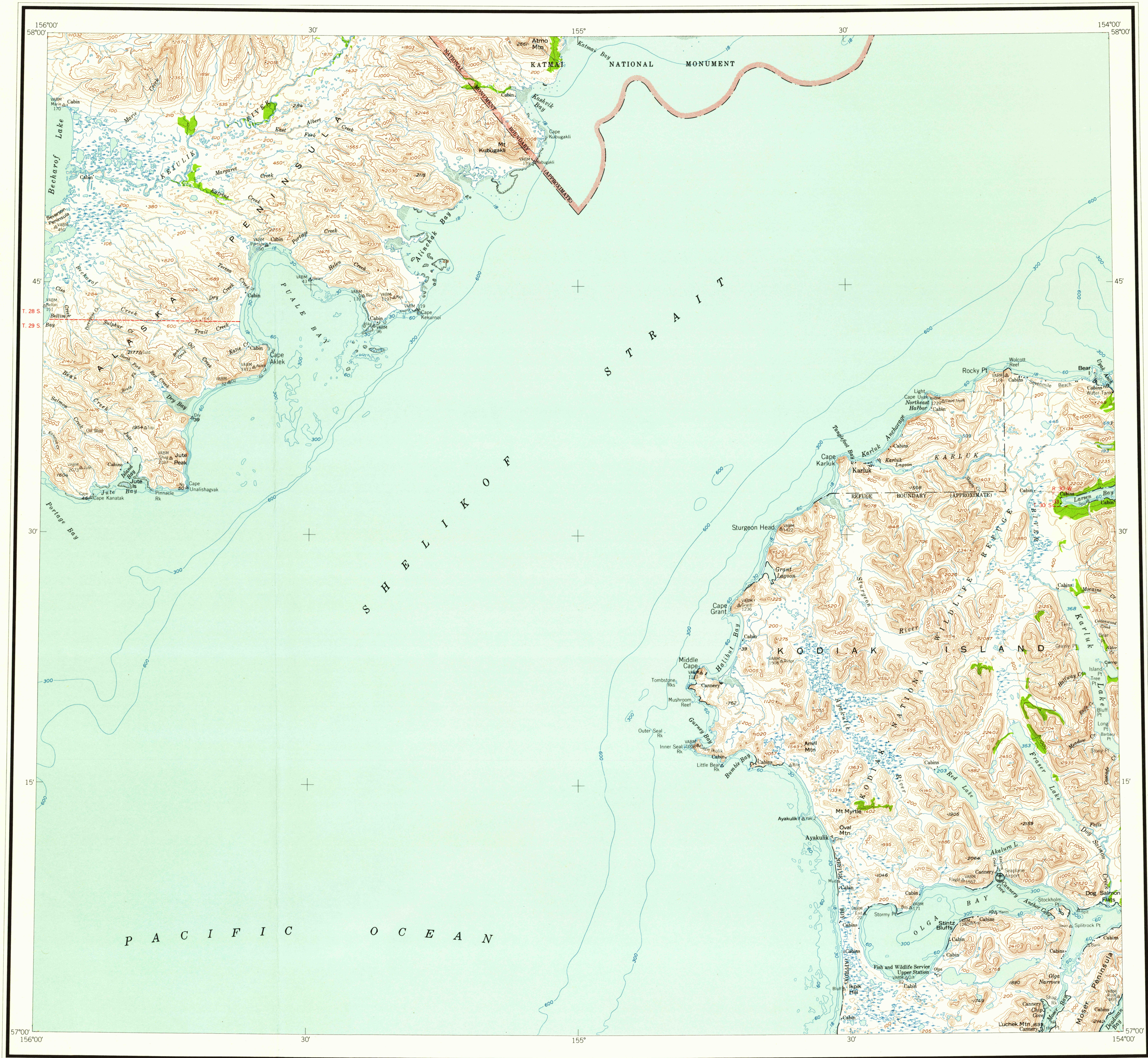

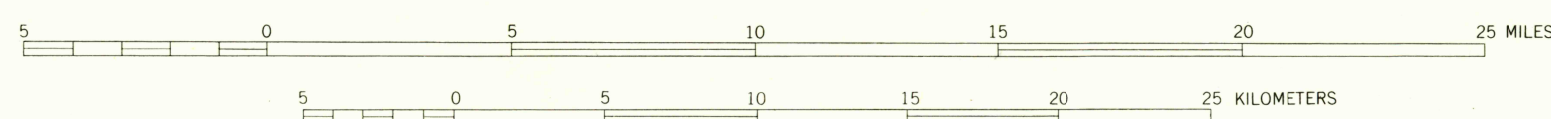
UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR PROJECTION, ZONE 5

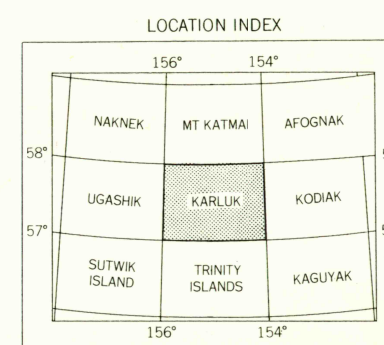
1955 MAGNETIC DECLINATION AT SOUTH EDGE OF SHEET VARIES FROM 20°30' TO 21°30' EAST
