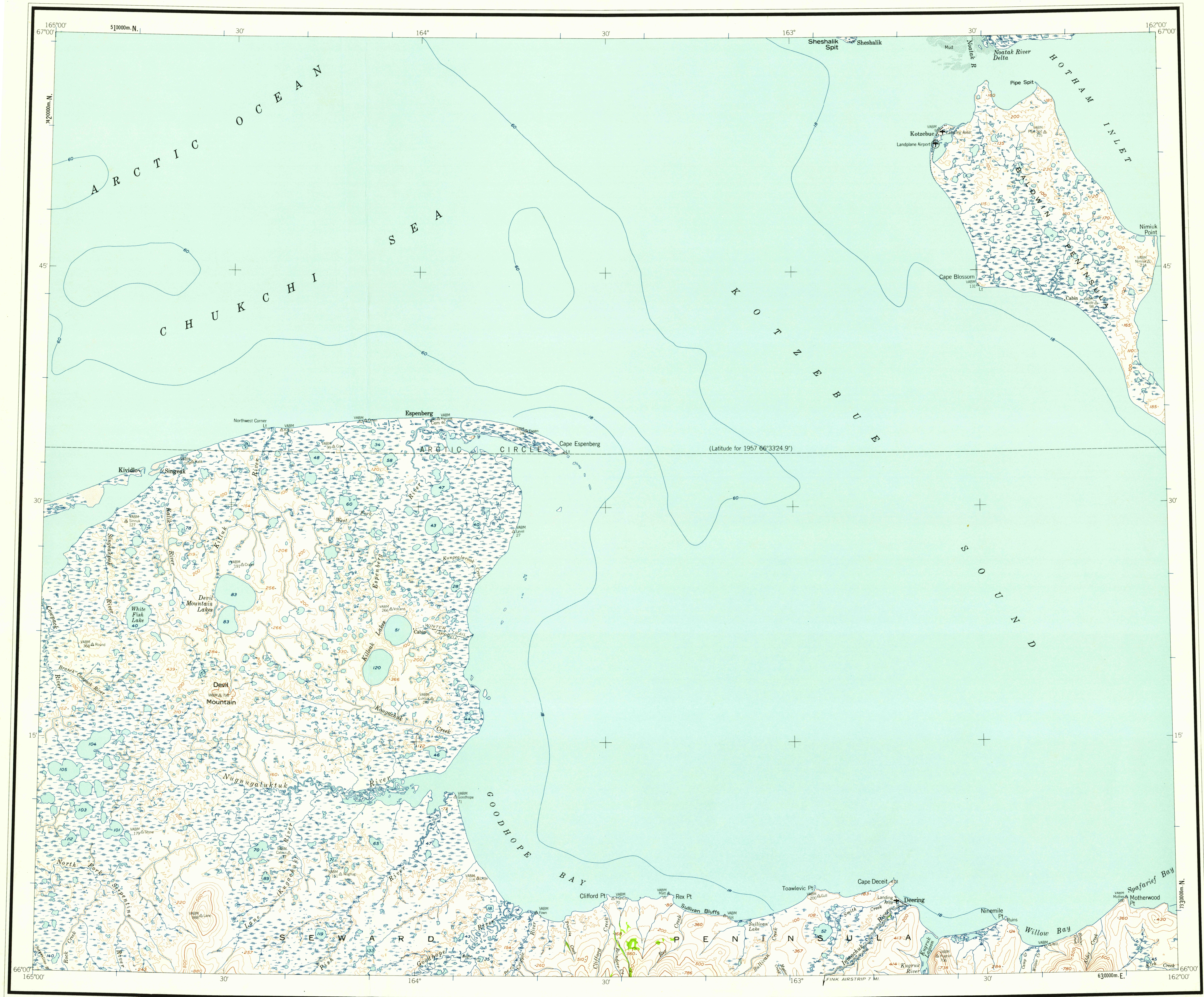
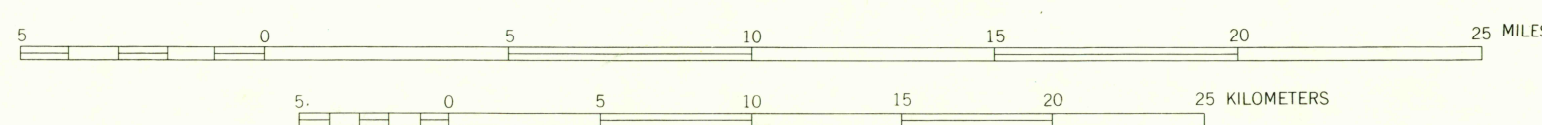

UNCHECKED ELEVATIONS ARE SHOWN IN BROWN AND BLUE

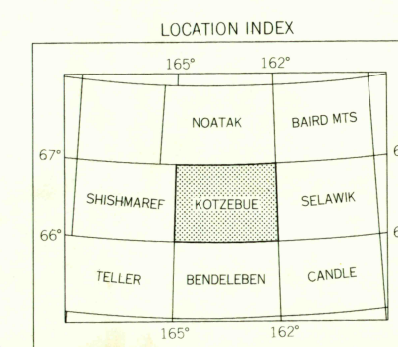
