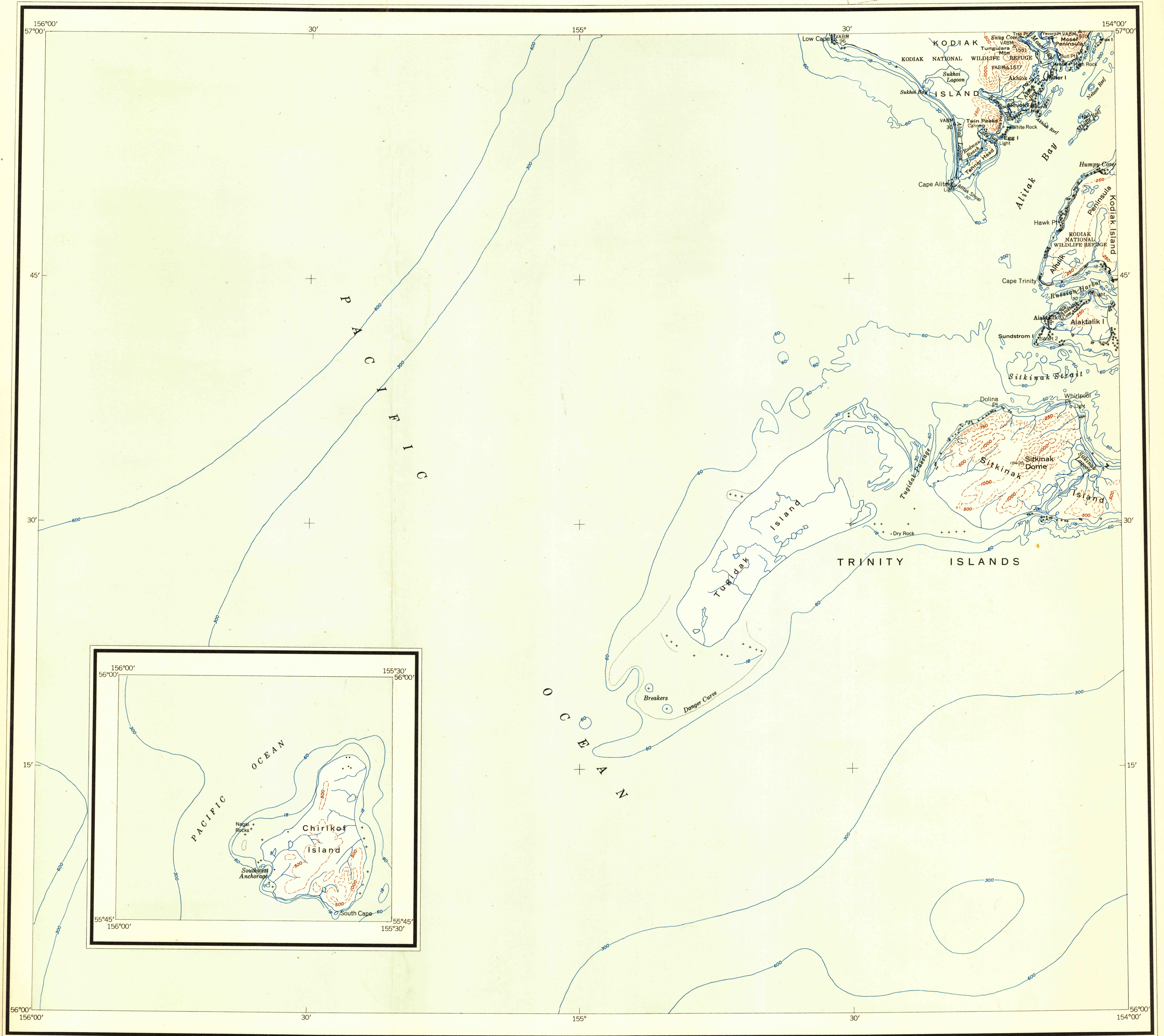

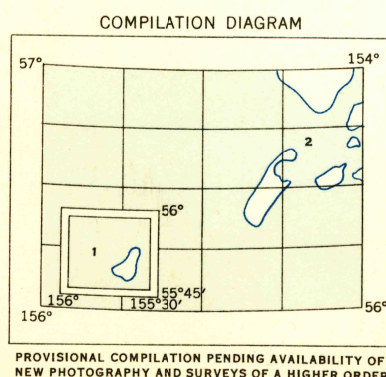

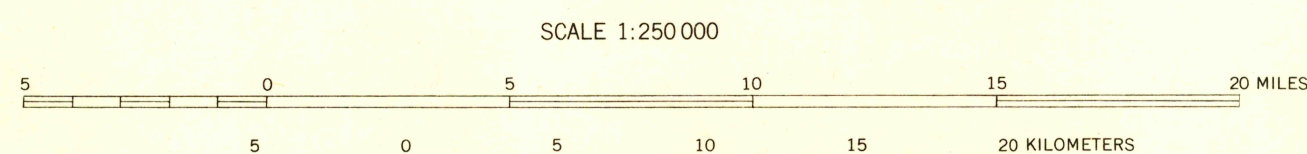

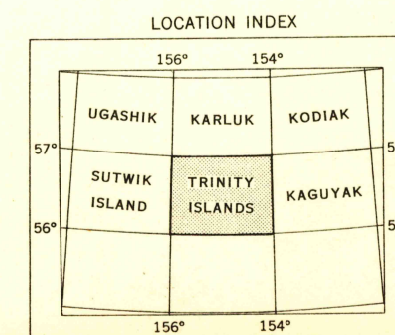


1. TOPOGRAPHY FROM USC&GS
