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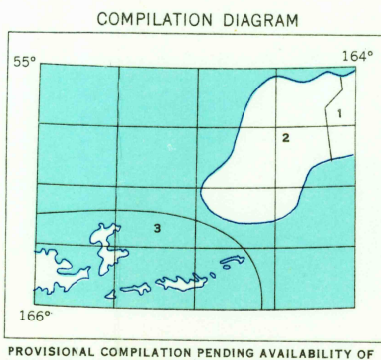

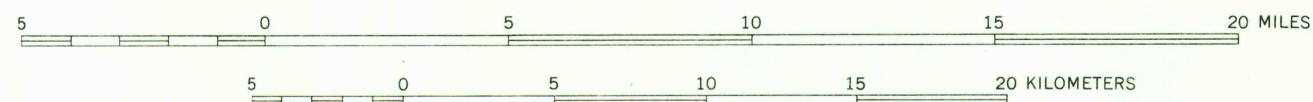

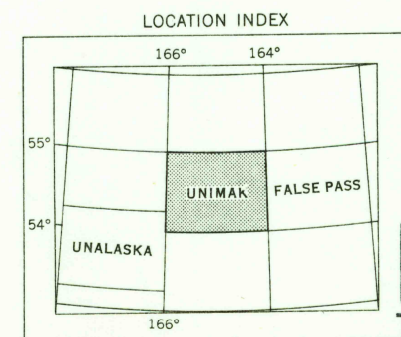
1951 MAGNETIC DECLINATION AT SOUTH EDGE OF SHEET VARIES FROM 16° TO 16°30' EAST
