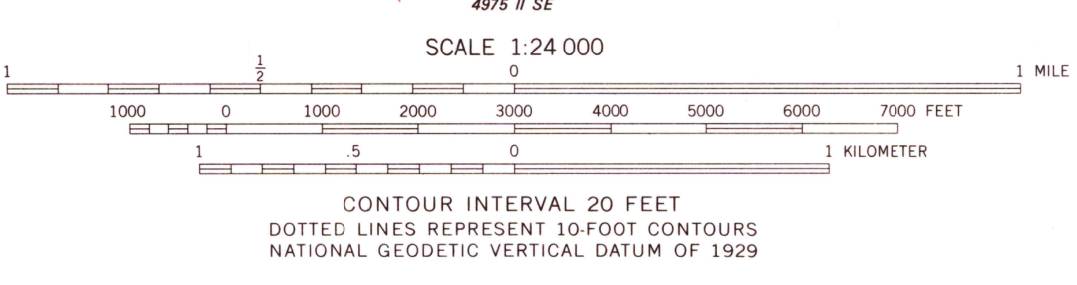
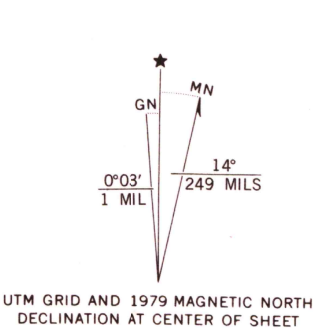
RATTLESNAKE RIDGE QUADRANGLE
