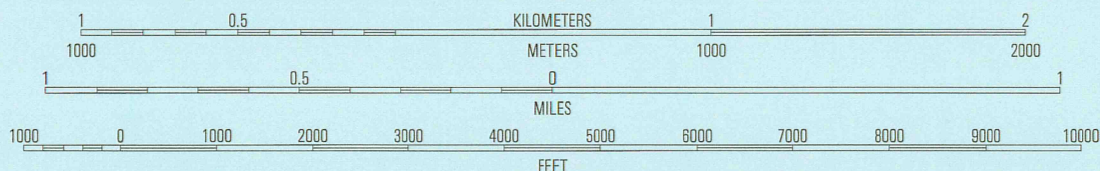

TOPOGRAPHIC MAP OF THE MANUA ISLANDS EAST AMERICAN SAMOA

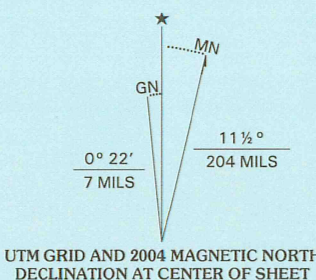
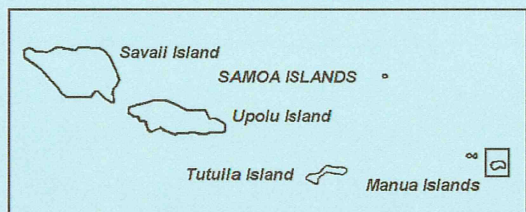
