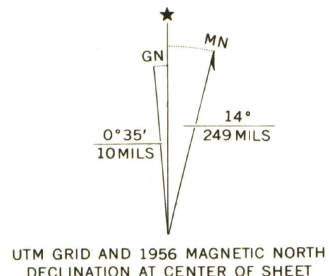

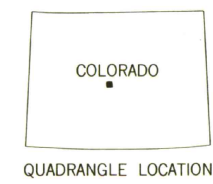
ANTERO RESERVOIR QUADRANGLE
