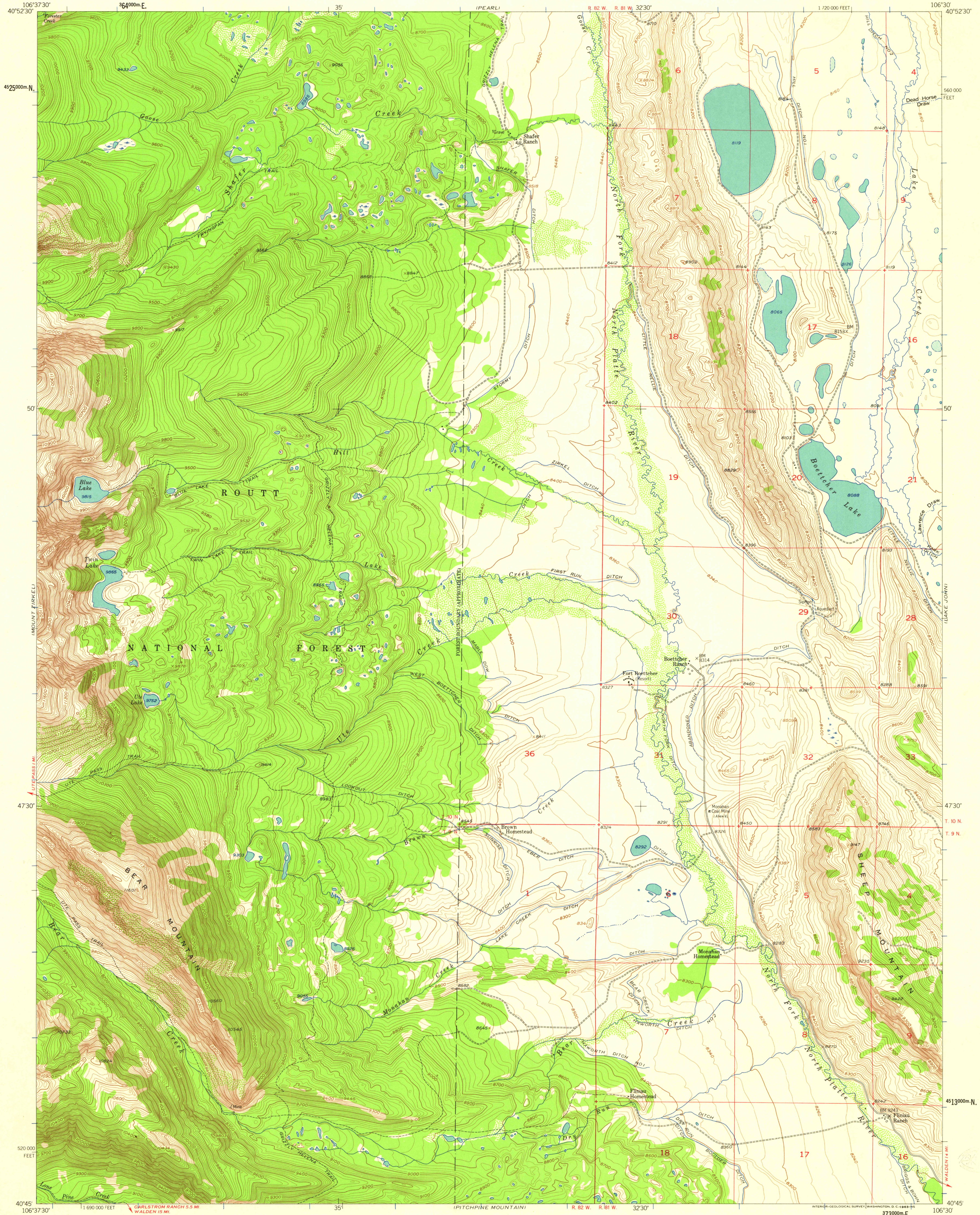

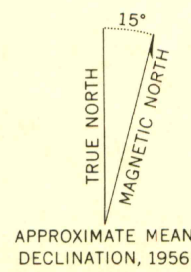

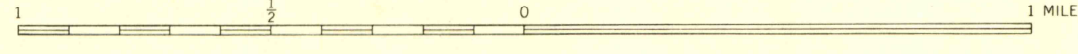

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue



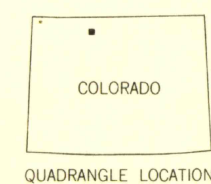
APPROXIMATE MEAN DECLINATION, 1956
