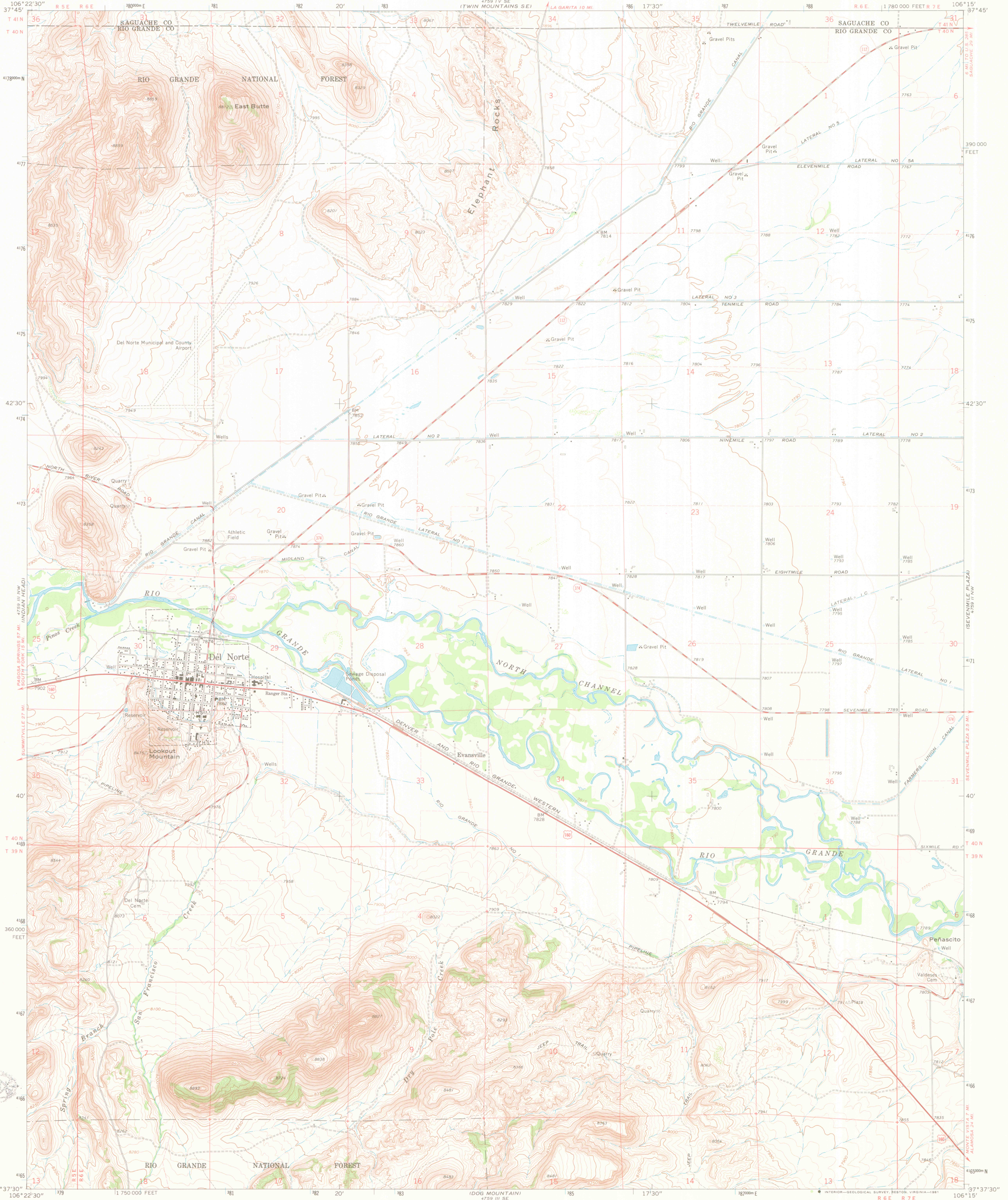

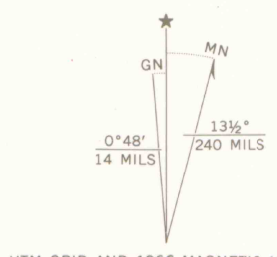
10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system,

zone 13, shown in blue

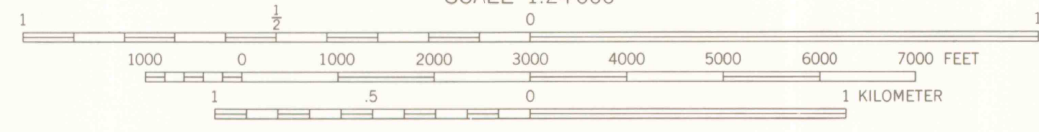
