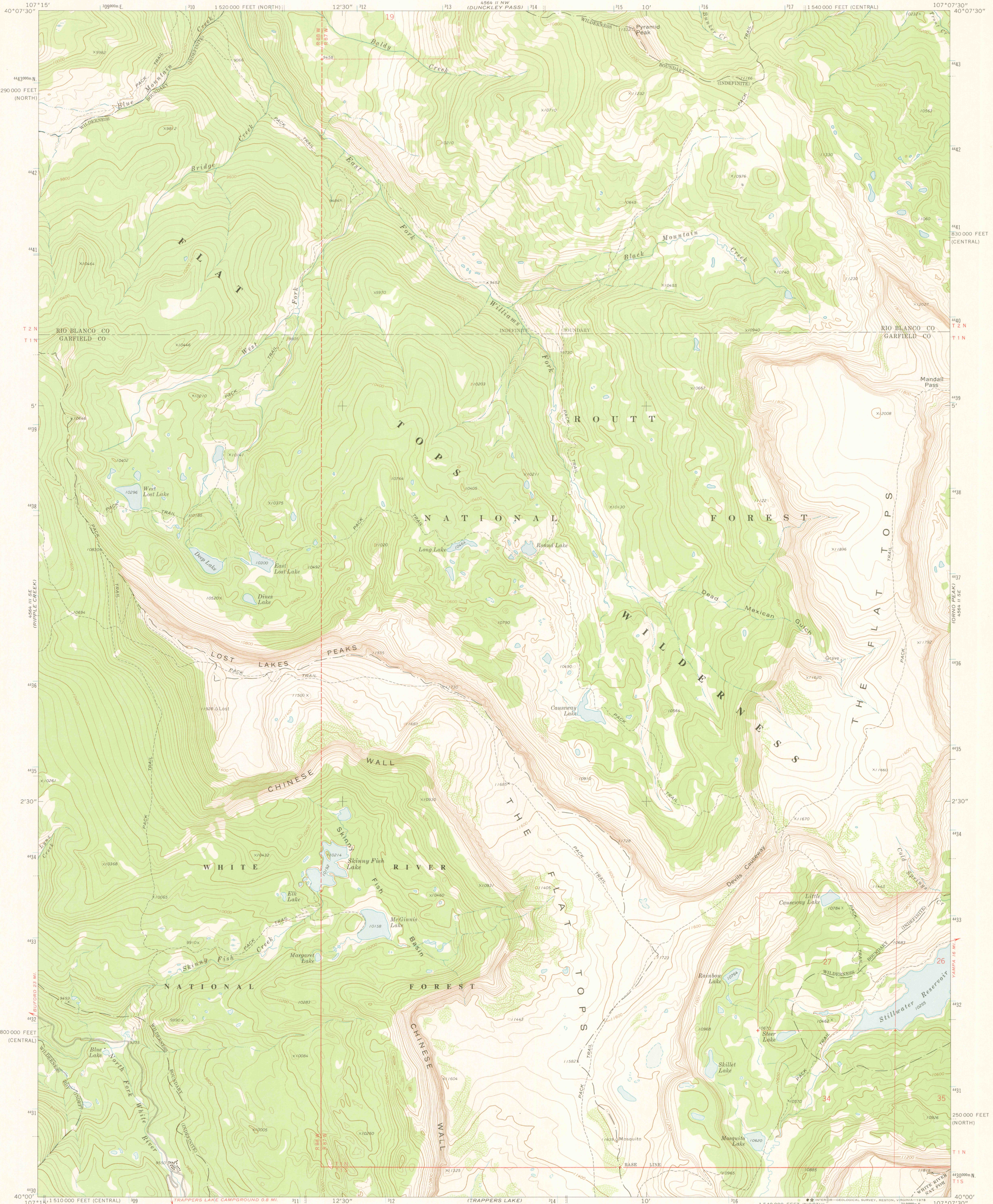
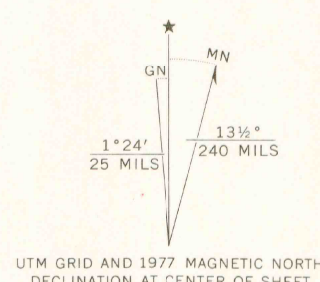

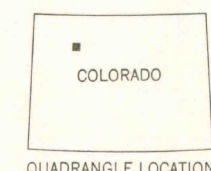
DEVILS CAUSEWAY QUADRANGLE
