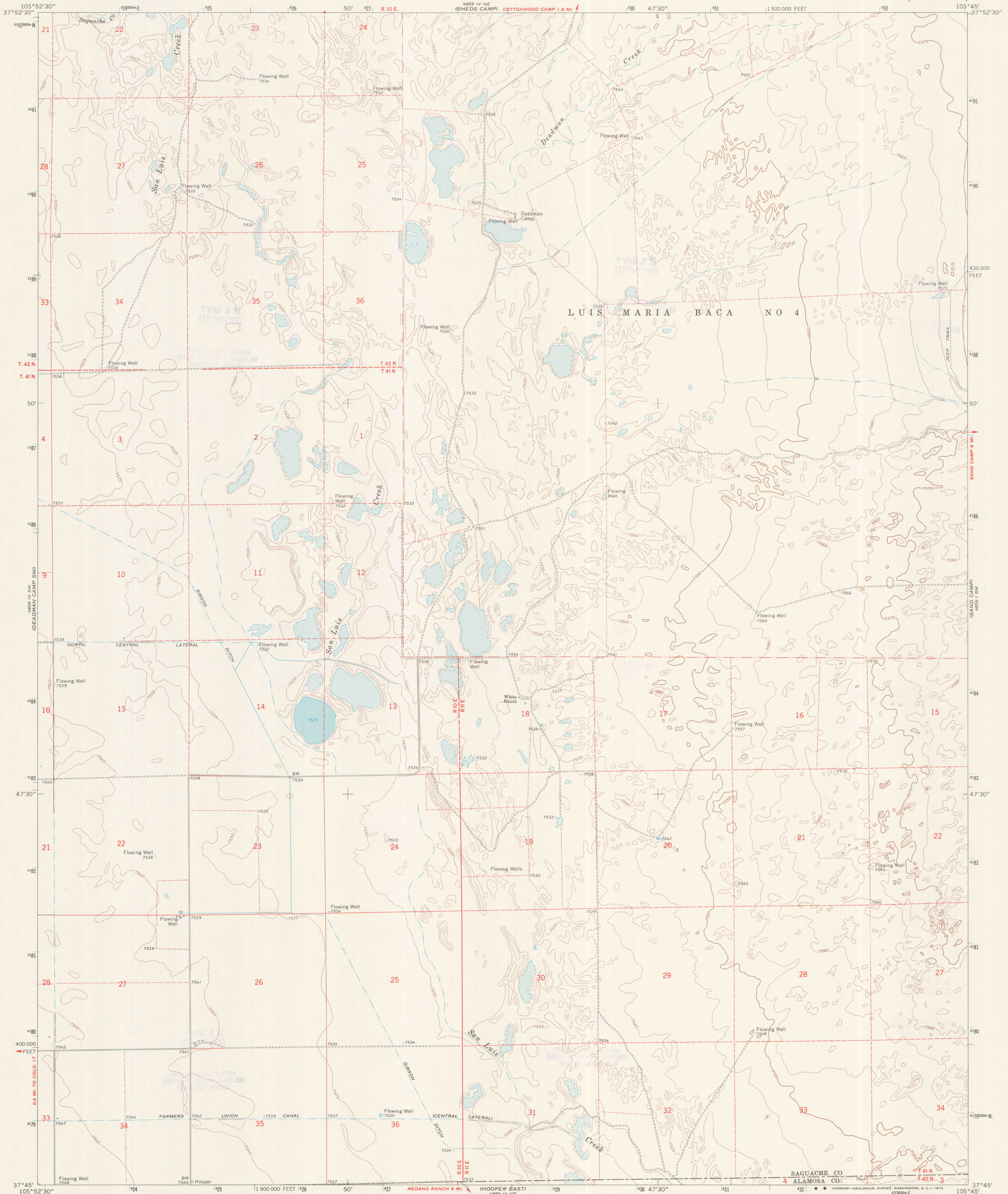

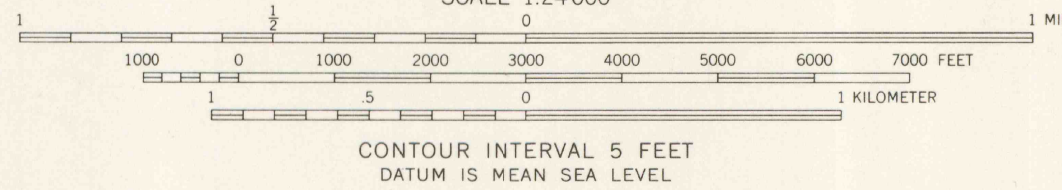
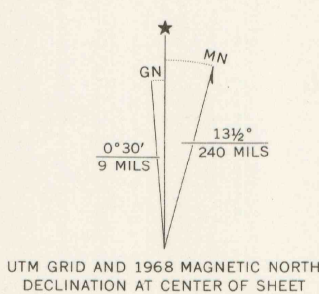
DEADMAN CAMP QUADRANGLE

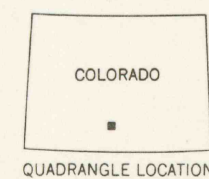
