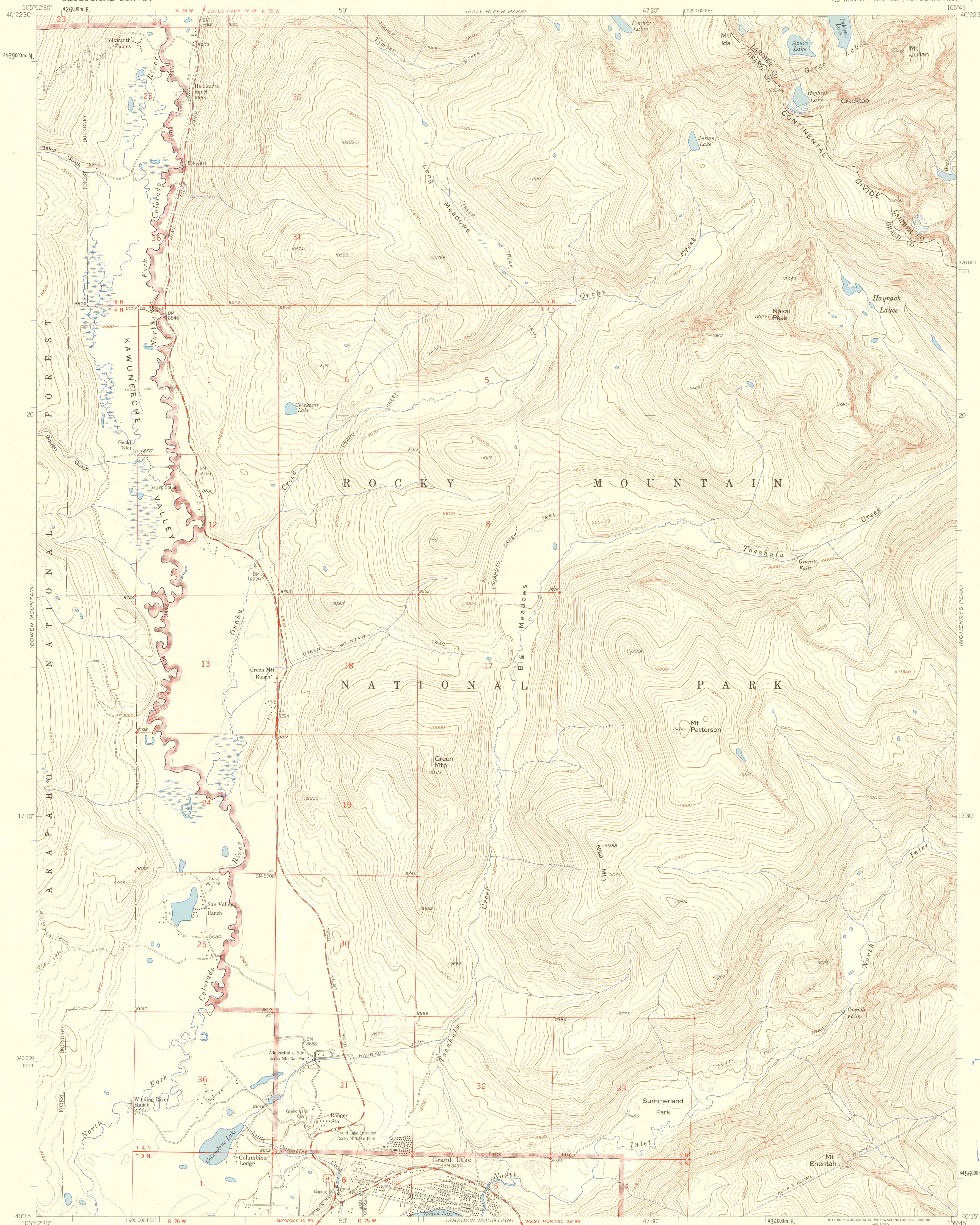

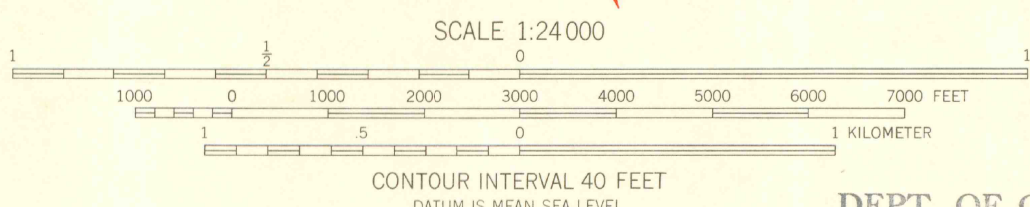
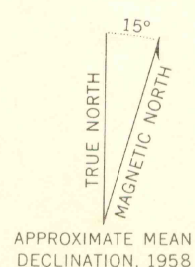

Certain land lines omitted in T. 3, 4, and 5 N.

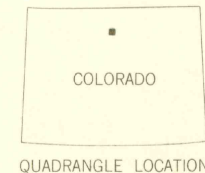
