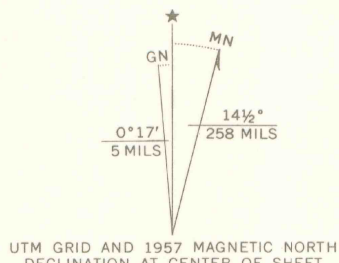

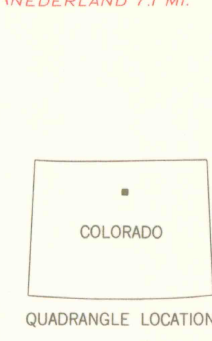
GOLD HILL QUADRANGLE
