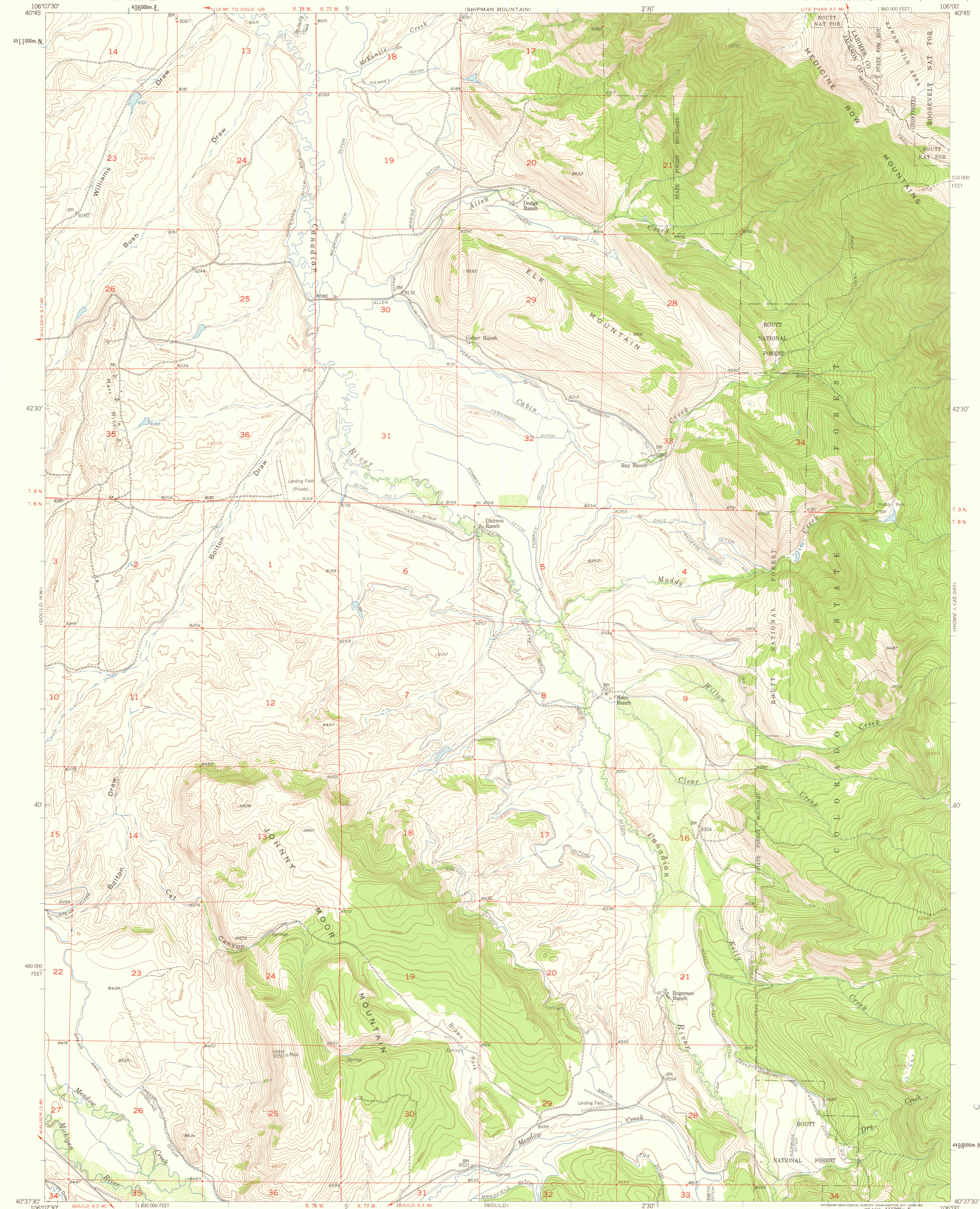




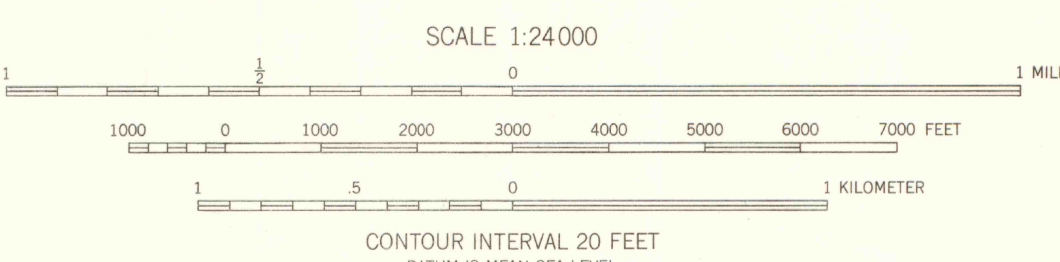
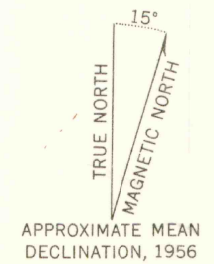

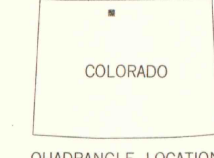
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. Certain land lines are omitted in T. 8 and 9 N., R. 77 W. because of insufficient data.
