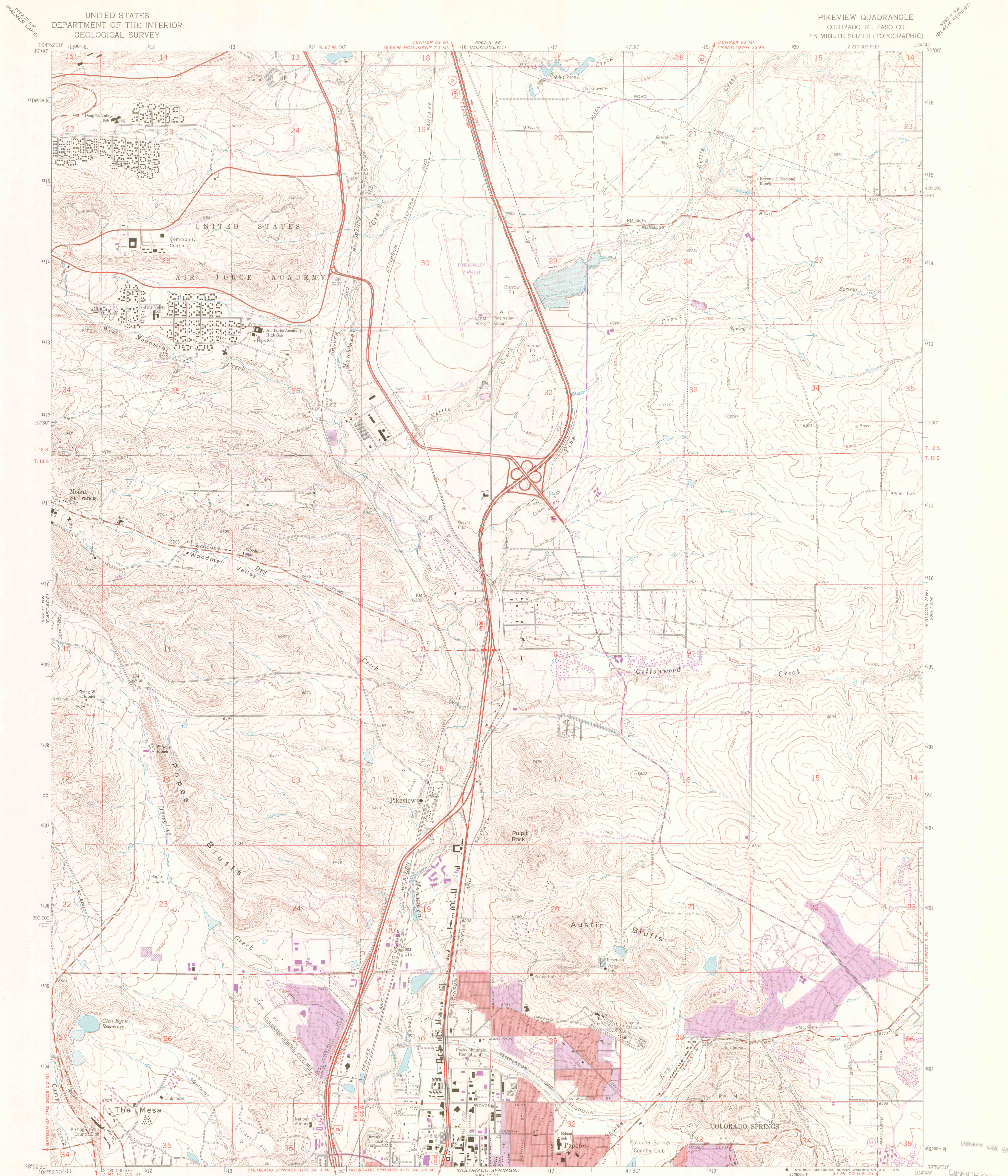


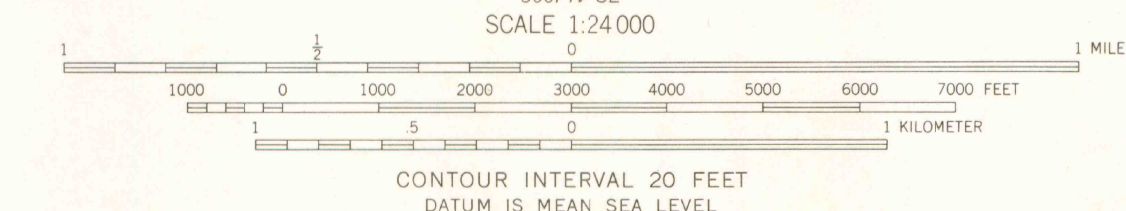

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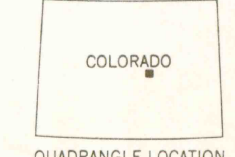

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
Area covered by dashed light-blue pattern is subject to controlled inundation
