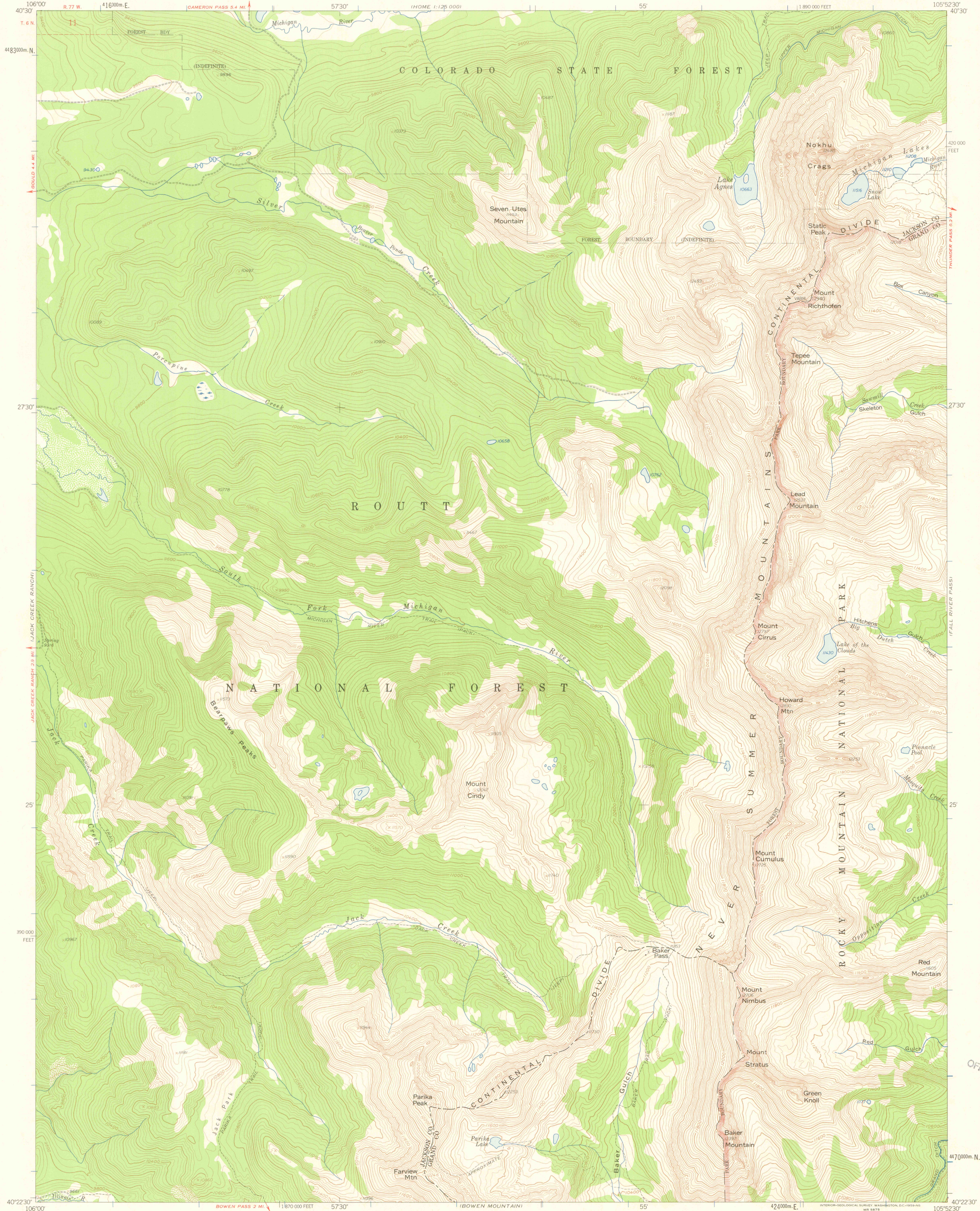

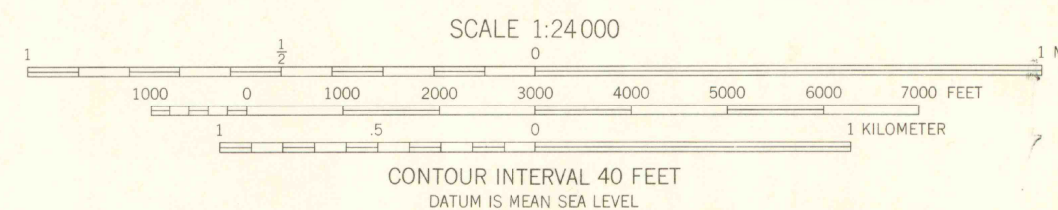
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

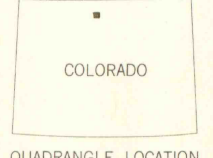
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
