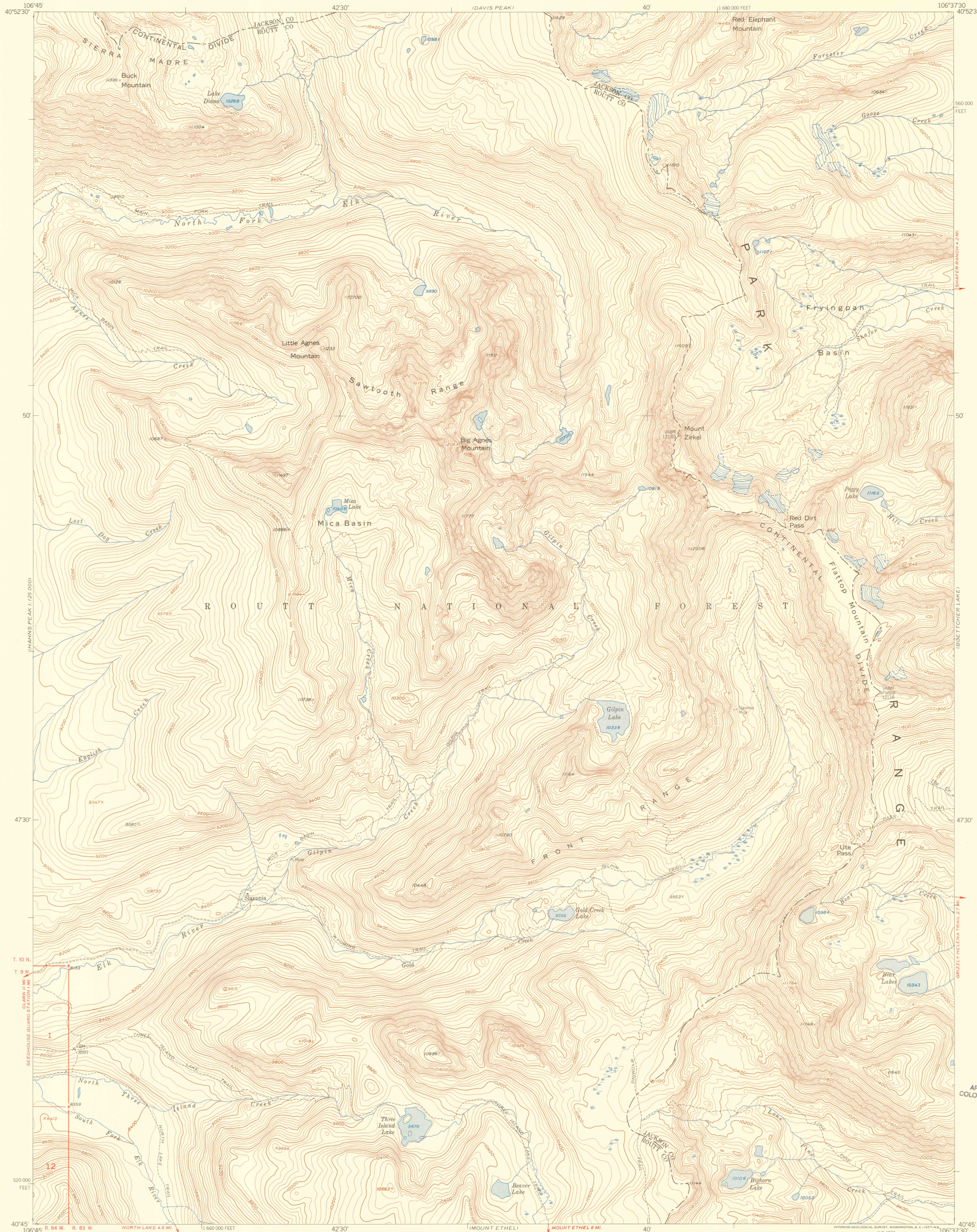




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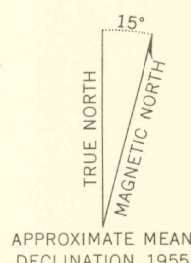

Aerial photographs taken 1952 Field check 1955

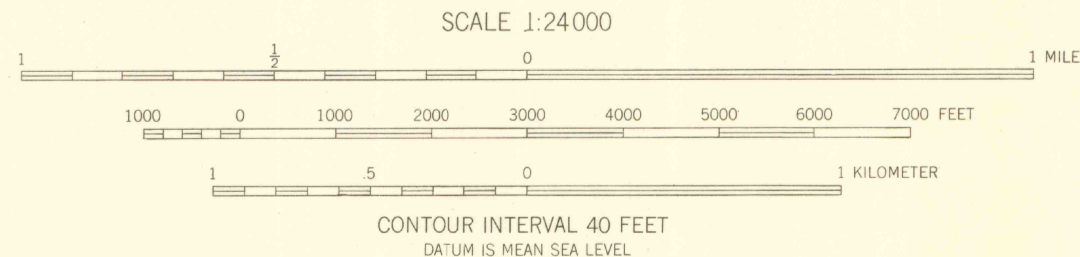
Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum

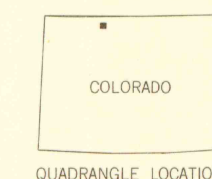
