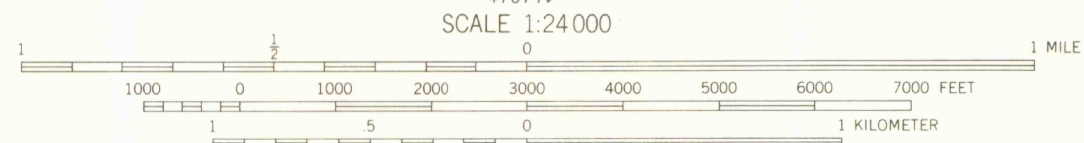
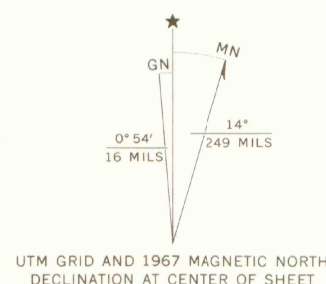

Twin Lake Reservoir at elevation 9208 feet



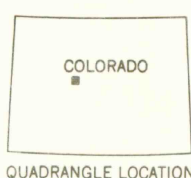
